Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Logan and Nelsonville-York clash for the 31st time tonight at Logan Chieftain Stadium. The game marks the 86th official meeting between the two communities when games between the old Nelsonville Greyhounds are included. While Logan has an overwhelming lead in the all-time series, the Buckeyes have won two of the last three meetings and since 1992 Logan's lead in the series is only 8-6.

The Buckeyes have rebounded from their season opening loss against rival Trimble, recording victories over perennial power Newark Catholic (9-0), Berne Union (49-12), and resurgent River Valley (28-7). Logan dropped a pair of heartbreakers to start the season, losing 43-42 in double-overtime against Lancaster and 44-40 against Teays Valley. Logan trounced Meigs 55-7 in week three, but fell to Loudonville last week 43-13.

- **2013 Round Up** First year head coach Billy Burke brought a new attitude to Logan Chieftain Stadium, daring the Chieftains to "Restore Order" – declaring the intent to return discipline, expectations, and a winning attitude to the sideline. Despite an 1-3 start, Logan won 5 of their final six games on their way to securing the school's 26th SEOAL football championship.

The Buckeyes finished 2013 with a 4-6 record, their first losing season since 1999 and their third since 1971. The Buckeyes' losses included one against a state finalist (Trimble) and two against regional finalists (Athens and Newark Catholic).

- **The Friendly Confines** Logan is back at home for the first time since their season opening loss to Lancaster. The Chieftains' stay will be short, as the schedule takes them to Portsmouth and Jackson to open SEOAL play in the next two weeks.
