## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight is the 92nd gridiron meeting between Jackson and Logan, both founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League. Logan (350) and Jackson (330) are the two all-time winningest schools in SEOAL history and have combed for 48 football championships (Logan 26, Jackson 22).

The Ironmen enter tonight's contest with a perfect 6-0 record, including a win over Warren (28-5) in their league lid lifter last week. The Ironmen beat 2013 playoff qualifiers West Jefferson (28-0), Bishop Ready (42-14), and Wheelersburg (27-0) in consecutive weeks prior to the win over Warren.

Logan opened the season with back to back narrow losses against Lancaster (43-42, 2 OTs) and Teays Valley (44-40), but have rebounded to win three of their last four games. The Chieftains opened the SEOAL portion of the schedule with a 32-7 win over Portsmouth last week.

- **Ranked Opponents ....** Jackson is the second LHS opponent to hold a place in the Associated Press Poll this season. In week four Loudonville was ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in Division VI (currently 3<sup>rd</sup>) while the Ironmen currently sit 10<sup>th</sup> in Division III.
- **De facto SEOAL title game? ....** Logan and Jackson have combined to win at least a share of the SEOAL title in 17 of the last 20 seasons. That alone is evidence of how important this rivalry is to deciding the championship. When you throw in that only five teams remain in the league and the remaining league schedule for each school features only one school with more than one win (Gallipolis is 2-4), it's safe to assume that tonight's game will likely determine the 2014 champion.
- **Chiefs in Alumni Stadium ....** This will be Logan's fifth trip to Jackson's Alumni Stadium which opened in 2004. Logan is 2-2 in the new building. The Chieftains were victorious on their first two trips to the new stadium winning 14-7 in 2005 and 48-7 in 2008, but the Ironmen have won the last two meetings here by scores of 49-28 (2010) and 31-20 (2012).
- **A shutout "shutout" ....** When Portsmouth scored a touchdown with 2:17 to play last week, it extended Logan's record streak without recording a shut-out to 41 games. Logan last recorded a shut-out against Marietta in 2010. The two previous record stretches without recording a shut-out were from 2003-2006 (35 games) and from 1982-1985 (28 games).
- **Most played opponents ....** Logan has played Jackson 91 times, more than any other opponent in their history. Below are the Chieftain's most played rivals:
  - 1. Jackson – **91 games**; 46-41-4 (1<sup>st</sup> game 1917, last game 2013)
  - 2. Athens – **88 games**; 49-34-5 (1<sup>st</sup> game 1914, last game 2007)
  - 3. Nelsonville (NHS & NYHS) – **86 games**; 68-14-4 (1<sup>st</sup> game 1913, last game 2014)
  - 4. Gallipolis – **82 games**; 41-40-1 (1<sup>st</sup> game 1920, last game 2013)
  - 5. Wellston – **57 games**; 39-14-4 (1<sup>st</sup> game 1915, last game 1981)
  - 6. Lancaster – **45 games**; 8-33-4 (1<sup>st</sup> game 1912, last game 2014)
- **SEOAL ....** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the SEOAL championship after a runner-up finish to Logan last season. The Ironmen return 21 of 24 starters after a 6-4 (3-1) finish in 2013. Logan was slotted as the runner-up, with Portsmouth third, Gallipolis fourth, and Warren fifth.
