## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight is the 28<sup>th</sup> meeting between Logan and Warren since the Warriors joined the SEOAL in 1986. Every meeting has been an official SEOAL contest. Logan leads the all-time series 23-5, but broke a two-game losing streak with last season's 49-22 win in the 2013 season finale.

Warren enters tonight 1-8 overall and 0-3 in the SEOAL under first year head coach Anthony Fish. The Warriors defeated Washington County rival Marietta in week two for their only victory. Warren exploded for 43 points last week, but fell to Portsmouth 58-43.

The Chieftains are 4-5 overall and 2-1 in the SEOAL and are looking to finish the season with a record of .500 or better for the second straight season under coach Billy Burke. Logan defeated Gallipolis 28-7 last week.

- **Halloween ....** Halloween has been more treat than trick for Logan historically. The Chieftains are playing on Halloween for the 12 time in school history, and hold a 10-1 record (including one forfeit victory) on October 31. Eight of the previous 11 Halloween games have come against SEOAL opponents and one was a playoff victory against Dublin Jerome (2008).
- **Grounded ....** Logan's junior quarterback, Lane Little, will miss tonight's game due to a suspension imposed by the OHSAA after being ejected in last week's victory against Gallipolis. Still, the junior has moved his way up the all-time record list at Logan High School.

The junior's 1,438 passing yards and 107 completions are fourth most ever by a Chieftain quarterback in a season. In fact, his 113 career completions are already ninth on the career list. His 14 TD passes stand 7<sup>th</sup> on the all-time list.

Senior receiver Chance Cox is eighth on the single season list with 41 catches, but will likely be playing quarterback in place of Little tonight. Junior Isaiah Smith has 36 catches, tied for tenth on the same list. Smith's seven touchdown catches are tied for 6<sup>th</sup> on the single season list.

- **Ground gainer out ....** Junior running back Bryce McBride, the team's leading rusher and second leading tackler, is out for tonight's game after suffering an injury early in the first quarter against Gallipolis last week. McBride averaged over 8.6 yards per carry and scored ten touchdowns this fall, and was the "big play" threat out of the backfield for Logan.
- **A shutout "shutout" ....** When Gallipolis scored in the fourth quarter of Logan's 28-7 victory over Gallipolis last week, Logan's record streak without recording a shut-out stretched to 44 games. Logan last recorded a shut-out against Marietta in 2010. The two previous record stretches without recording a shut-out were from 2003-2006 (35 games) and from 1982-1985 (28 games).
- **SEOAL ....** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the SEOAL championship after a runner-up finish to Logan last season. The Ironmen return 21 of 24 starters after a 6-4 (3-1) finish in 2013. Logan was slotted as the runner-up, with Portsmouth third, Gallipolis fourth, and Warren fifth.
