## Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight is the return trip of Logan's home and home series with Hamilton Ross. The Rams, members of the Southwest Ohio Conference, made the long trip to Logan last season which the Chieftains won 23-0. Ross is just the second Butler County opponent in school history following a 1924 match-up with Hamilton High School.

The Rams enter 0-8 and ride a 15-game losing streak under first year head coach Kenyon Commins. Ross, whose new base offense is triple-option and run heavy, has yet to allow more than 36 points in a single game. Ross fell to Little Miami last week 14-7.

Logan is a disappointing 2-6 overall in their first season as an independent since that last trip to Butler County in 1924. The Chieftains fell to Dublin Scioto 42-7 last week in their Homecoming match-up. Logan recorded victories over Meigs (26-22) and Minford (48-42, 2OT).

- **What a long strange trip ....** As Craig Dunn reported in the Logan Daily News this week, the trip from Logan to Ross Ram Stadium can be as short as 153 miles and as long as 161 miles, making it the likely longest trip by mileage in school history. As mentioned above, Logan visited Hamilton, the Butler County seat, in 1924 a trip that today measures between 142 and 163 miles depending on your chosen route. Logan likely made that trip by train and "bunked" at the Hamilton Hotel the night before the game. The Chieftains dropped a 48-9 decision.
- **On this date ....** Tonight is Logan's 12<sup>th</sup> game ever played on October 20, with the Chiefs holding a 9-2-1 record on the date. All but one – a 22-0 win over Jackson in 1922 – were Southeastern Ohio Athletic League contests. Logan has played their old SEOAL rival six times on October 20, winning all but two of those games including lopsided 62-14 shellacking in 2000.
- **Billy's back ....** Head coach Billy Burke is back for his fifth season in charge of the purple and white. Only four (of 32) LHS coaches' have coached more than five seasons at the school. Burke is 23-20 so far at LHS and won Logan's 26<sup>th</sup> Southeastern Ohio Athletic League championship in his first season (2013). Burke's staff includes five former Chieftains.
- **Youth movement ....** After seeing only four freshmen earn varsity letters in *fifty years*, the purple and white saw four freshmen earn letters in 2016 alone. Three of those letter winners are back in addition to six juniors who were starters as sophomores last season. Rounding out the youth movement, Dakota Dement was the first underclassman to serve as captain since 1920. Logan hopes that last year's growing pains become this season's success stories.
- **Noteworthy captains ....** Speaking of captains, a trio of seniors – Dakota Dement, Carter Hodson, and Brady Walsh – have been named full time captains for the 2017 season. Dement is the first multi-year captain since Anthony Schrader was captain in 1920-1921 and just the third all-time. Walsh, a quarterback and safety, is the son of LHS assistant coach Pat Walsh.
- **Into the wilderness ....** Logan High School is without an athletic league or conference for the first time since the 1924-25 school year. The Southeastern Ohio Athletic League – which once was home to schools such as Athens, Gallipolis, Ironton, Jackson, Marietta, and Portsmouth - indefinitely suspended operations in the spring. Prior to that, the league had been the longest continually operation non-city league in the state of Ohio. Logan was one of only two founding members to compete in every school year of the league's existence.
