Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the 91st meeting between these ancient rivals in a series Logan leads 51-34-5. The Chieftains have won the last fourteen meetings, however, the two teams didn't meet from 2008-2014 following the Bulldogs departure from the SEOAL. Logan had a pair of 10-0 teams during that stretch while the Bulldogs had three undefeated teams and a fourth finish 9-1 overall. Athens last victory over Logan came here at Rutter Field in 1995 when Kahieem Maxwell blew up for 270 rushing yards and added an 87 yard kick-off return for a total of four touchdowns.

In last season's game, a winless Logan team upset Athens by blocking the potential game-tying extra point with 0:32 left to play. Logan trailed 24-10 over halfway through the third quarter before a trio of touchdown passes rallied the Chieftains to a 31-24 lead. Logan won the game 31-30.

- **The Streak** Logan's winning streak over Athens stretches back 14 games and 21 seasons. During the streak, Logan has outscored the Bulldogs 591 (42ppg) to 197 (14 ppg) including six games where the Chieftains scored 50 or more points. Logan, in fact, has scored at least 28 points in all but one game against the 'Dogs during the streak. Conversely, Athens has been shut-out four times and scored more than two touchdowns only five times (including the last two meetings).

It's only fair to point out, however, that in seasons when the two teams have played during the streak, Logan has averaged seven wins and made five playoff appearances while the Bulldogs have averaged three wins and failed to make the playoffs. From 2008-2014, the stretch where the two schools did not play, the Bulldogs were a dominating 65-17 overall (over nine wins per season) with four playoff appearances, three trips to the regional finals, one state final appearance, and three 10-0 regular seasons while Logan was barely above .500 (39-35) with a pair of 10-0 seasons and a pair of playoff victories.

There have been 412 different players to appear on a Logan roster in the fourteen Chieftain victories.

- **Not just the players** According to Troy Bolin of WXTQ/Power 105.5 in Athens, the Athens coaching staff includes former Bulldog players in head coach Ryan Adams ('90), Kris Kostival ('87), Nathan White ('99), and Matt Goodwin ('97) who combined for a paltry 3-9 record as players against the purple and white. The foursome is yet to defeat Logan as coaches since Adams took over the reins in 2007.

Conversely, Logan's coaching staff includes five former Chieftains with a combined 14-1 record against the Bulldogs. The staff includes Jimmer Breining and Pat Walsh (1989), Tim Woodgeard ('95), Brian Breining ('97), and Josh Sturgell ('04). Walsh joined the Varsity staff back in 1997 and none of the former playoffs have coached in a varsity loss against the Bulldogs.

- **Born into this** Longtime fans will surely recognize two backfield players in tonight's game. Logan quarterback Brady Walsh is the son of LHS assistant coach Pat Walsh, who was 3-0 against the Bulldogs from 1986-1988 while Bulldog running back Evan Adams is the son of head coach Ryan Adams who lost to Walsh's Chieftains in '86 and '87 before finally knocking off Logan in 1989. Adams was named the SEOAL MVP in 1988 and 1989 and is one of only four players to ever repeat as the league's player of the year.
- **On this date** Tonight is the Chieftains' twelfth game ever played on September 29th and first since 2006 when Logan defeated Zanesville 33-6. Logan is 8-3-1 on September 29 with all but two of those games coming against SEOAL opposition. In non-league games played on this date, Logan recorded an 18-0 victory over McArthur in 1933 and suffered a 12-0 setback at Lancaster in 1928. Logan previously defeated Athens on September 29th in 1967 (14-6) and 2000 (62-14) – both of those victories were played at Bill Sauer Field in Logan.
- **Billy's back** Head coach Billy Burke is back for his fifth season in charge of the purple and white. Only four (of 32) LHS coaches' have coached more than five seasons at the school. Burke is 23-20 so far at LHS and won Logan's 26th Southeastern Ohio Athletic League championship in his first season (2013). Burke's staff includes five former Chieftains.
- **Youth movement** After seeing only four freshmen earn varsity letters in *fifty years*, the purple and white saw four freshmen earn letters in 2016 alone. Three of those letter winners are back in addition to six juniors who were starters as sophomores last season. Rounding out the youth movement, Dakota Dement was the first underclassman to serve as captain since 1920. Logan hopes that last year's growing pains become this season's success stories.
- **Noteworthy captains** Speaking of captains, a trio of seniors – Dakota Dement, Carter Hodson, and Brady Walsh – have been named full time captains for the 2017 season. Dement is the first multi-year captain since Anthony Schrader was captain in 1920-1921 and just the third all-time. Walsh, a quarterback and safety, is the son of LHS assistant coach Pat Walsh.
- **Into the wilderness** Logan High School is without an athletic league or conference for the first time since the 1924-25 school year. The Southeastern Ohio Athletic League – which once was home to schools such as Athens, Gallipolis, Ironton, Jackson, Marietta, and Portsmouth - indefinitely suspended operations in the spring. Prior to that, the league had been the longest continually operation non-city league in the state of Ohio. Logan was one of only two founding members to compete in every school year of the league's existence.
