## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight marks the eighteenth overall meeting between Logan and Meigs, and the fourth since the series was renewed in 2014. Meigs is celebrating its 50-year anniversary – and were members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League with Logan until 1982. The two teams did not play between 1982 and 2014. Last season Meigs recorded their first victory over Logan since 1981 in a 25-19 win at the new Marauder stadium in Rock Springs.

Logan is 0-2 overall, falling to Dublin Jerome (41-7) and Teays Valley (35-7). The Chieftains were 3-7 last fall. Meigs is 1-1, recording a come from behind season opening victory over rival Gallipolis (14-8) and falling to visiting St. Clairsville (47-6) last week.

- **(Un)special Teams ....** Last Friday night wasn't a banner night for Chieftain kickoff and punt teams. Teays Valley returned the opening kickoff 91 yards for a touchdown and later recorded an 87-yard kickoff return in the second quarter following the team's lone touchdown. To make matters worse, the Vikings returned a bouncing punt 39-yards for a third special teams touchdown.

It marked the first time in the history of LHS football that the Chiefs allowed opponents to return more than one kick return for touchdown.

- **Youth movement ....** After seeing only four freshmen earn varsity letters in *fifty years*, the purple and white saw four freshmen earn letters in 2016 alone. Three of those letter winners are back in addition to six juniors who were starters as sophomores last season. Rounding out the youth movement, Dakota Dement was the first underclassman to serve as captain since 1920. Logan hopes that last year's growing pains become this season's success stories.
- **Noteworthy captains ....** Speaking of captains, a trio of seniors – Dakota Dement, Carter Hodson, and Brady Walsh – have been named full time captains for the 2017 season. Dement is the first multi-year captain since Anthony Schrader was captain in 1920-1921 and just the third all-time. Walsh, a quarterback and safety, is the son of LHS assistant coach Pat Walsh.
- **Oh captain, my captain ....** Speaking of Dakota Dement, the senior lineman has a chance to return to the Chieftain line-up tonight after recovering from an offseason injury. The senior played as both a guard and defensive tackle in 2016 and should boost an offensive line that needs to improve for Logan to spark a struggling offense.
- **Into the wilderness ....** Logan High School is without an athletic league or conference for the first time since the 1924-25 school year. The Southeastern Ohio Athletic League – which once was home to schools such as Athens, Gallipolis, Ironton, Jackson, Marietta, and Portsmouth - indefinitely suspended operations in the spring. Prior to that, the league had been the longest continually operation non-city league in the state of Ohio. Logan was one of only two founding members to compete in every school year of the league's existence.
- **On this date ....** Tonight marks the seventh Chieftain football game played on September 8 and the first since 2006, a 31-7 victory over Pickerington North. Logan is 5-2 on this date, with both losses coming in season openers against Bexley in 1961 (8-12) and against New Lexington in 1972 (8-43). The Chieftains have won their last four games on September 8, defeating St. Francis DeSales in 1989 (17-14), Nelsonville-York in 1995 (21-18), Zanesville in 2000 (27-21), and the victory over Pickerington North in 2006.
