Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** The Logan Chieftains entertain the Zanesville Blue Devils at Logan Chieftain Stadium tonight, the 24th meeting between the two schools. ZHS leads the series 13-10. The quirky series saw Zanesville win the first 9 games, including eight wins from 1991-1998 before Logan won the next ten between 1999 and 2009. Zanesville has won the last four, including a 27-13 win last season.

Zanesville sits at 5-1 on the season, but are *oh, so close* to being a perfect 6-0. The Blue Devils led nearly the entire game until Wheeling Park (WV) scored with :48 left, and when they converted the PAT it gave the Patriots a 35-34 win. Zanesville has wins over arch-rival Newark (35-0), perennial small-school power Johnstown-Monroe (35-25), area rival Tri-Valley (28-18), and River View (49-13). They beat Mount Vernon 38-30 last Friday.

Logan beat archrival Athens last week 46-20, their second straight victory. Logan started the season 0-4, with losses to Tri-Valley (35-7), Teays Valley (10-7), Jackson (28-7), and Sheridan (14-7). The Chiefs got their first win over Chillicothe (18-7), which snapped a school record 11-game losing streak. Logan's back-to-back wins are the first since weeks nine and ten in 2016.

- **Who to watch: Logan** The Chieftain offense averages nearly 246 yards per game, with just over 183 per game coming on the ground. Junior running back *Caden McCarty* ran for 139 yards and two touchdowns on 22 carries last week against Athens while *Braeden Spatar* added 89 yards on 14 carries and his first touchdown while throwing for 90 yards and a touchdown on seven of nine passing. Receiver *Colten Castle* caught two passes for 55 yards and a touchdown and also added a two-point reception. Junior *Jonny McClelland* saw an increased role in the slot, rushing five times for 31 yards and catching two passes for 18 yards.

Defensively, the purple and white are allowing 256 yards per game, but only 110 per game on the ground. Last week Logan intercepted Athens QB Joey Moore four times, with *Colten Castle* grabbing a pair of thefts including one he returned 60-yards for a touchdown. *Jonny McClelland* and *Garrett Mace* also made interceptions. Junior *Ian Frasure* made a significant contribution as a defensive back for the first time, including a touchdown saving tackle on the Bulldog's first series.

- **Who to watch: Zanesville** The Blue Devils average over 36 points and nearly 345 yards per game while operating from a pass-first but not only offense led by senior quarterback *Ben Everson*. He has completed 89 of 130 passes for 1156 yards with 17 touchdowns and only four interceptions while also running for 290 yards and five scores on 66 rushing attempts. Top targets are *Jeremiah Norman* (20 catches, 310 yards, 3 TDs) and *Jamal Wiggins* (20 catches, 277 yards, 7 TDs).

Defensively the Blue Devils are yielding just over 20 points 327 yards per game. The secondary is greedy, having intercepted nine passes in just 111 attempts, or nearly one theft per 12 attempts. *Julius Murphy* and *Casey Cassell* lead the secondary while *Gaige Burnett* and *Zarek Morgan* are veteran linebackers.

- **That's called a winning streak** Logan, winners of back-to-back games for the first time since 2016, are looking for their first winning streak since the 2015 season. That year the Chieftains finished 8-2 and won their opening six games. Logan's win over Chillicothe two weeks ago snapped a school record long 11-game losing streak.
- **Meet the new boss** Mike Eddy was named Logan's 31st head football coach in January. The new Chieftain boss had a 52-52 career record at Gallipolis and Parkersburg South (WV) High Schools. A graduate of Tyler County (WV) High School and Fairmont State University, Eddy was an assistant at powerhouse Parkersburg (WV) High School from 2004-2008. His 2012 Gallia Academy team won an SEOAL championship and advanced to the second round of the OHSAA DIII playoffs. He left Gallipolis with a 24-18 overall record.
- **Veteran and local coaching staff** Coach Eddy retained the majority of the existing coaching staff, while also welcoming back former Chieftain head coach and long-time assistant coach Kelly Wolfe. Wolfe, who was head coach from 2010-2012, had previously been an assistant from 1990-2009.

Eddy's staff includes five former Chieftains who all were captains during their playing days. Eddy and assistant Jim Huntsberger are the lone non-LHS graduates, but Huntsberger has been on Logan's coaching staff since 1990.

- **On this date** Logan has played 15 games on October 11, winning 11, losing three, and tying 1. The first game played on Oct. 11 was back in 1912, a 27-0 victory over Groveport and 100-years ago tonight the Chieftains defeated Nelsonville 30-0. Six years ago Logan defeated Jackson 28-21 on their way to their last league championship.
