Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** The Logan Chieftains travel to The Plains to take on their ancient rival, the Athens Bulldogs. The 93rd meeting between the two teams doesn't have league title implications the way it did from 1925-2007, but for players, fans, and especially coaches, it's a circled game on the schedule. Logan leads the all-time series 51-36-5. The Bulldogs have won the last two matchups, including just their third win in Logan since Athens consolidated with Chauncey-Dover and The Plains in 1967 last season.

Athens is 2-3 on the season, but has won their last two games. Their first three non-league losses came against teams who are a combined 14-1. Those losses came against Waverly (30-27), Jackson (31-26), and Parkersburg South (42-20). The Bulldogs opened TVC-Ohio play with wins over Alexander (28-6) and Vinton County (33-28).

Logan snapped a school record 11-game losing streak by knocking off the home standing Chillicothe Cavaliers 18-7 on Thursday Night Lights last week. Caden McCarty scored all three touchdowns for LHS. The Chieftains had opened with losses to Tri-Valley (35-7), Teays Valley (10-7), Jackson (28-7), and Sheridan (14-7).

- **Who to watch: Logan** The Chieftain offense averages nearly 222 yards per game, with nearly 165 per game coming on the ground. Junior running back *Caden McCarty* ran for 157 yards and three touchdowns on a whopping 37 carries last week against CHS while *Braeden Spatar* added 117 yards on 17 carries. Logan's interior line – guards *Trevor Wyckoff* and *Sam Kisor* along with center *Carson Miller* – dominated in the ground game.

Defensively, the purple and white are allowing just less than 240 yards per game, nearly evenly split between aerial and ground attacks. Senior linebacker *Colton Ruff* was outstanding against Chillicothe recording a team high 10 tackles (8 solo, 4 for loss) and a sack. His twin brother, *Conner Ruff*, returned to the lineup after missing the first four games recovering from a knee injury. Up front, *Josh Chapin* and *Henry Pierce* had strong performances against the blue and white.

- **Who to watch: Athens** The Bulldog offense relies on the skill and ability of quarterback *Joey Moore* who leads the green and gold with 1,204 passing yards, including 14 touchdowns and only four interceptions, on 86-60 passing while also rushing for a team high 377 yards and four touchdowns on 93 carries. No other Bulldog has even 20 carries in the first five games. *Nate Trainer* and *Peyton Gail* lead a talented group of skill players with 35 catches for 522 yards and four scores and 16 receptions for 138 yards and a score respectively.

Defensively the Athenians are allowing nearly 350 yards per game, including 228 (and 5.28 per carry) on the ground. *Isaiah Butcher* is a monster noseguard, standing at 6-foot-5 and 275 pounds. *Trainer* is a standout in a hybrid defensive back/linebacker role while *Corbin Stalder* and *Aiden Kostival* are standout linebackers.

- **Breaking his duck** Mike Eddy was named Logan's 31st head football coach in January, and his Chieftains finally delivered his first win last week against Chillicothe. The new Chieftain boss had a 52-52 career record at Gallipolis and Parkersburg South (WV) High Schools. A graduate of Tyler County (WV) High School and Fairmont State University, Eddy was an assistant at powerhouse Parkersburg (WV) High School from 2004-2008. His 2012 Gallia Academy team won an SEOAL championship and advanced to the second round of the OHSAA DIII playoffs. He left Gallipolis with a 24-18 overall record.
- **Veteran and local coaching staff** Coach Eddy retained the majority of the existing coaching staff, while also welcoming back former Chieftain head coach and long-time assistant coach Kelly Wolfe. Wolfe, who was head coach from 2010-2012, had previously been an assistant from 1990-2009.

Eddy's staff includes five former Chieftains who all were captains during their playing days. Eddy and assistant Jim Huntsberger are the lone non-LHS graduates, but Huntsberger has been on Logan's coaching staff since 1990.

- **On this date** Logan has played 13 games on October 4, going 6-6-1 in those games. Included in that number are five games against Athens, with Athens leading 3-1-1 in those matchups. This will be just the second non-league game on October 4 in LHS history and the first since 1929.
