## **Game Notes:**

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Ancient rivals Jackson and Logan renew their rivalry tonight at Alumni Stadium in Jackson. The pair will meet as non-league opponents for the first time since 1924 after the disbandment of the old Southeastern Ohio Athletic League. The two schools were both founding members of the league and two of the most successful members. Logan won 26 titles with Jackson winning 25 over its 92 years of existence.

Logan has played Jackson 95 times, first in 1917, the most played opponent in Chieftain history. Logan has played Athens 92 times and Gallipolis 84. Logan played Nelsonville 55 times and Nelsonville-York 33 for a combined 88 games against their Hocking Valley rivals.

The **Jackson Ironmen** enter the contest with a perfect 2-0 record following wins over two other former SEOAL members. The Ironmen closed out their 108-game series with Wellston with a 23-6 win and held off a comeback by the Athens Bulldogs to escape with a 31-26 win last week. Jackson has reached the playoffs the last two seasons, but have their sights set on advancing past the first round for the first time since 2015.

**Logan** is looking to rebound from a program worst 1-9 record last season and are currently riding the longest losing streak in school history at nine games. Logan led Teays Valley 7-3 at halftime last week, their first lead since defeating Meigs in week three of 2018. The Vikings returned the opening kick off of the second half and held on for a 10-7 victory as Logan's last-minute field goal attempt bounced off the crossbar. Logan lost in week one to Tri-Valley by a 35-7 score line.

- **Who to watch: Logan ....** Logan had two runners surpass the century mark last week for the first time since 2014. Quarterback *Braeden Spatar* ran for 104 yards while also completing 9 of 11 passes for 65 yards while *Caden McCarty* ran for 110 yards and a touchdown. Logan controlled the clock, holding the ball for 32:01.

Defensively Logan put together one of their most complete performances of the last few seasons, holding Teays Valley to only 5 first downs and 72 yards of total offense. Junior *Johnny McClelland* was active from his hybrid outside linebacker/safety position while defensive linemen *Henry Pierce* and *Josh Chapin* recorded 7 and 5 tackles respectively. Senior *Colton Ruff*, a three-year starter who played against the Ironmen in 2016, is the heart of the purple and white defense.

- **Who to watch: Jackson ....** On offense quarterback *Jared Icenhower* is in his third year as a starter where he is surrounded by what Coach Andy Hall believes is the best group of skill players he has coached. *Jayden Spires* and *Brice Graham* are dangerous running backs while *Tristan Prater*, *Garrett Daily*, and *Jacob Winters* are threats on the edges.

On defense, the Ironmen have allowed only 63 rushing yards on 46 attempts combined in their season opening victories. *Mitchell Johnson* is a disruptor as an undersized noseguard while *Treyllan Davis* and *Grant Mastin* are stout against the run game. *Brice Parks* is one of the area's top defensive backs.

- **New sheriff in town ....** Mike Eddy was named Logan's 31<sup>st</sup> head football coach in January. The new Chieftain boss had a 52-52 career record at Gallipolis and Parkersburg South (WV) High Schools. A graduate of Tyler County (WV) High School and Fairmont State University, Eddy was an assistant at powerhouse Parkersburg (WV) High School from 2004-2008. His 2012 Gallia Academy team won an SEOAL championship and advanced to the second round of the OHSAA DIII playoffs. He left Gallipolis with a 24-18 overall record.
- **Welcome back ....** One of the first moves Eddy made after accepting the LHS head coaching job was to put together the rest of his coaching staff. An early call was made to Kelly Wolfe, former legendary player and head coach at LHS. Wolfe is back on the Chieftain sideline following a six-year hiatus and will be the offensive coordinator, quarterbacks coach, and offensive play caller. Wolfe previously coached in some capacity from 1991-2012.

Eddy's staff includes five former Chieftains who all were captains during their playing days. Eddy and assistant Jim Huntsberger are the lone non-LHS graduates, but Huntsberger has been on Logan's coaching staff since 1990.

- **Millennial game on the way ....** Logan will play its 1,000<sup>th</sup> football game since becoming a Varsity sport in 1912. Currently, Logan has played 998 total games winning 568, losing 393, and tying 37 for a .587 win percentage. Logan's 1,000<sup>th</sup> game will come next week in a home matchup with the Sheridan Generals.
- **On this date ....** Logan is 6-4-1 in games played on September 13, including a 28-13 victory over Jackson in 2002. Logan also defeated Columbus St. Francis DeSales on this date in 1991 by a 27-13 score and played one of the most memorable games in school history when they beat Miami Trace 40-33 on this date in 1985.

Logan has played 33 total games on Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>; winning 18, losing 14, and tying 1. Logan defeated Canal Winchester 31-0 in 1914 in their first Friday the 13<sup>th</sup> game and most recently lost to Dublin Scioto 42-7 in 2017. Memorable games include a 64-0 pasting of Nelsonville in 1959, the aforementioned wins over Miami Trace and SFD, a 31-7 victory at Gallipolis in 2000, and a 21-10 loss to Columbus Brookhaven in the second round of the playoffs in 2009.
