Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the first ever Varsity football contest between Logan Elm and Logan. The game completes a trio of first time opponents – all from the Mid-State League Buckeye Division – scheduled following the schedule reset caused by the COVID-19 global health crisis.

Logan Elm is riding a two game winning streak and enters with a 2-2 overall record. The Braves fell to Teays Valley (25-31) and Hamilton Township (18-41) to open the season before knocking off rival Circleville (41-22) and Fairfield Union (34-14).

Logan is still searching for their first win having fallen to Jackson (14-48), Amanda-Clearcreek (12-17), Warren (14-28), and Bloom-Carroll (0-14). Those four teams are a combined 14-2 overall.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Logan focused on its ground attack in last week's shutout loss to Bloom-Carroll. Senior running back *Caden McCarty* ran for 70 yards on 22 carries. *Henry Pierce*, a tight end in the opening three games, stepped into the H-back role vacated by the injured Traten Poling and caught a pair of passes for 12-yards and had a great game as a blocking back.

Defensively junior lineman *Carson Hodson* recorded a team high 11 tackles with senior linebacker *Quinn Walsh* brought down a personal best 10 ballcarriers. *McCarty* recorded 10 tackles with two pass break-ups and blocked a field goal.

- **Who to watch: Logan Elm** *Connor Robinson* completed 17 of 20 passes for 164 yards and two touchdowns while running for 72 yards and another score on 13 carries. *Blayton Reid* added 85 yards on 13 carries. *Gabe Chalfin* caught a team high six passes for 59 yards and returned the opening kickoff 85-yards for a touchdown.

Defensively the Braves held Fairfield Union to 264 total yards and 10 first downs. *Cole Westenbarger* is a versatile safety who plays in the box on running downs while *Collin Roar* is an anchor on the defensive line. *Matthew Dyer* stands out at linebacker.

- **On this date** This will be the thirteenth Chieftain football game ever played on September 25, with Logan holding an 9-3 record. Logan opened the 1925 season with a 12-10 win over Washington Courthouse on September 25th and topped Gallipolis 44-0 on their way to a 10-0 season in 1964. The 2009 11-1 team topped Ironton 21-7 on this date while most recently the 8-2 Chiefs topped Nelsonville-York 41-28 in 2015.
