Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight's matchup is the first ever meeting between the Amanda-Clearcreek Aces and the Logan Chieftains. The game is a result of rearranged schedules caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Logan will also face Mid-State League foes Bloom-Carroll and Logan Elm for the first time later this fall.

Amanda-Clearcreek is coming off an 9-3 season that saw them make their second playoff appearance under Coach Steve Daulton in his two seasons at A-C. The Aces beat Columbus Academy in the first round of the playoffs. Last week the Fairfield Countians had their game delayed in the first half causing them to finish their 35-7 victory over Fairfield Union on Saturday afternoon.

Logan won four of their final six games to finish 4-6 overall last fall with three of Logan's six losses coming by a single touchdown or less. The Chieftains put up their best defensive numbers in a decade and used a ball control offense to wear down opponents. Last week, Logan fell to perennial power Jackson 48-14. For Jackson, it was their 13th straight regular season victory.

- **Who to watch: Logan** On offense, senior quarterback *Ian Frasure* completed 16 of 39 passes for 146 yards and a touchdown while classmate *Caden McCarty* ran for 91 yards on 20 carries. Junior *Traten Poling* caught four passes for 38 yards and ran twice for ten yards and a touchdown.

Defensively *Carson Hodson* led the team with five solo tackles from his defensive tackle post while *Jonny McClelland* made four stops, broke up a pass, and recovered two fumbles.

- **Who to watch: Amanda-Clearcreek** For the Aces, *Nathan Hunter* completed 9 of 13 passes for 151 yards and a score while *Hunter Matheny* ran for 88 yards and a pair of touchdowns and also made a nine-yard touchdown reception. Amanda-Clearcreek returns a veteran forward line.

Defensively, linebacker *Quintin Lott* and *Dalton Stump* are outstanding while *Cade Young* is a versatile player at defensive end..

- **We are live** The Amanda-Clearcreek Athletics Department will have a live video stream of tonight's game on YouTube. The game can be watched by searching for "ac athletics" or by using the following link: <https://youtu.be/EdykDkJZV3M>

- **Captains** Logan named six captains this fall; Ian Frasure, Caden McCarty, Jonny McClelland, Henry Pierce, Traten Poling, and Quinn Walsh. McClelland is just the third two-time captain in school history while Poling is only the fourth underclassman to be named a captain.

McCarty joins his brother, Corey, who was captain in 2012 while Walsh follows in the footsteps of his father, Pat, who was a captain in 1988. Pat Walsh is currently a Varsity assistant.

- **By the numbers** Ian Frasure's 39 pass attempts were the most ever by a Chieftain in a regulation contest. Lane Little attempted 40 passes in Logan's overtime loss to Lancaster in 2014.

Jonny McClelland caught 6 passes for 80 yards last Friday – after catching 6 passes for 66 yards in the entire 2019 season.

- **On this date** This will be the sixth Chieftain football game ever played on September 4, with Logan holding a 4-2 record. The first game was a 26-0 season opening loss in 1981 and the last was a 27-7 victory over Teays Valley in 2015. The most memorable game played on September 4 might be Logan's 24-21 victory over Pickerington North in 2009. That night Derek Montgomery's last minute field goal clinched a win over the Panthers and helped propel Logan to a second straight 10-0 regular season.
