## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight will be the 97<sup>th</sup> meeting between the Logan Chieftains and the Jackson Ironmen – or the 98<sup>th</sup> if you include a 1906 game that predates Logan's official records. The Ironmen hold a narrow lead in the series thanks to their current five game winning streak over LHS.

**Jackson** is coming off another fine season, although the abrupt finish may have left a bad taste in the mouths of the Welshmen. No one laid a glove on Jackson through their first five games when they scored at least 40 points in every game and allowed no more than 14 in a single game. But a jarring 30-27 double overtime loss to Chillicothe followed by a 14-12 loss to Tri-Valley in their playoff opener saw the Ironmen finish 5-2.

**Logan** lost their first seven games – including a 62-0 humiliation in an OHSAA playoff loss to Big Walnut – before rebounding to win their final three games over Columbus East, Maysville, and Teays Valley.

- **Thursday night lights ....** Tonight will be Logan's 28<sup>th</sup> Thursday game in program history. Fourteen of the previous 27 games were played on Thanksgiving Day, with Logan going 10-1-1 against Nelsonville and 0-1 against Gallipolis on the holiday. During the 1930s through 1950s several games were moved to Thursday nights due to teaching conferences held at Ohio University on Fridays.

Overall Logan is 17-7-3 on Thursdays, including an 18-7 win over Chillicothe in 2019. That was Logan's first Thursday game since 1955.

- **Opening night jinx ....** Over the last twenty seasons the Chieftains are a dismal 4-16 in season openers. On the bright side, three of those four season opening wins ended in perfect 10-0 regular seasons.

Logan defeated New Lexington 13-12 in 2001, Lancaster in 2008 (35-10) and 2009 (33-14) and beat Athens 62-49 in 2015. In between those victories were lone losses to New Lex, Westerville South, and Jackson; nine losses to Lancaster; and two each against Dublin Jerome and Tri-Valley.

- **Who to watch: Logan ....** Logan will look a little different offensively, transitioning from a shotgun spread offense to a run-oriented wing-t attack. Right tackle *Keiton Arledge* will need to continue his excellent play while halfback *Traten Poling* and new starting quarterback *Brayden Sturgell* will be relied on as playmakers.

Defensively Logan must improve on a disappointing 2020 campaign. Linebackers *Justin Mustard* and *Poling* should be reliable while *Mason Linton* returns up front. *Sturgell* and sophomore *Jack Brown* are keys in the secondary.

- **Who to watch: Jackson ....** For Jackson, a backfield trio of *Jacob Winters*, *Evan Spires*, and *Cade Wolford* are versatile and athletic. Winters and Spires can both quarterback and running back while Wolford will be play in the slot, on the wing, and as a running back.

Defensively, *Winters*, *Spires*, *Grant Mastin*, and *Drew Bragg* lead a disruptive linebacker unit. *Wolford* and *Tristan Prater* lead an athletic secondary.

- **Captains ....** Logan's 2021 captains are seniors Keiton Arledge, Carson Hodson, Justin Mustard, and Traten Poling. Poling is the fourth two-time captain in school history joining Anthony Schrader (1920, 21), Dakota Dement (2016, 17), and Jonny McClelland (2019, 20).

Hodson joins his brother Carson (2017) as a full-time captain.

- **Common foe ....** Jackson and Logan are long time rivals, meeting 97 times on the gridiron since 1912. The two teams also met in 1906 prior to official LHS records. Jackson leads the all-time series 47-46-4 and the overall score is separated by just seven points. Both schools were founding members of the SEOAL with Logan winning a record 26 titles and Jackson winning 25.

Jackson, currently riding a five-game winning streak over Logan, can equal their longest winning streak over the purple and white. They previously won 6 straight meetings between 1926-1932.

- **On this date ....** Tonight will be the earliest opener in school history and the first game played on Aug. 19. The previous earliest start dates came on Aug. 22 in both 2003 (0-29 loss at Westerville South) and 2008 (35-10 win over Lancaster).
