## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight is the first ever meeting between St. Charles Preparatory and Logan High School. The two Division II school's will meet again next season on the east side of Columbus to complete a home and home contract.

**St. Charles** lost a heartbreaking 31-28 decision in overtime last week against Central Catholic League rivals Bishop Watterson. The Cardinals opened the season with losses to Big Walnut (0-41) and Eastmoor Academy (6-34) before winning at Amanda-Clearcreek (14-9). The red and black have lost their last three to Youngstown Chaney (3-22), Cuyahoga Falls Walsh Jesuit (0-40), and Watterson.

**Logan** won their first game of the season last week topping rival Athens 24-14. The win was on the back of a narrow defeat at Chillicothe (21-23) following a one-week hiatus due to COVID contract tracing protocols. Logan was humbled in their first three games of the season against Jackson (7-42), Teays Valley (6-49), and Sheridan (0-33).

- **Playoffs !?!?!?! .....** Believe it or not, despite each team having only one victory, the winner of tonight's game could strengthen a potential playoff berth with a second win tonight. The OHSAA has doubled the size of the playoff field to 16 teams per region. St. Charles currently sits 16<sup>th</sup> in the region while Logan is 20<sup>th</sup> in the Division II, Region 7 Harbin computer points rankings according to JoeEitel.com.
- **Who to watch: Logan ....** Logan ran for 226 yards on 50 carries last week with a balanced running attack that saw three different runner cross the goal line. Logan's leading rusher *Traten Poling* gained 77 yards on 10 carries, but suffered a second quarter knee injury that will keep him out of the lineup for tonight. Quarterback *Brayden Sturgell* ran for 39 yards and a score while completing all three pass attempts for 24 yards. *Tyler Dawson* ran for 13 yards and a score from the fullback post.

Defensively the Chieftain forced three turnovers including a long fumble return by cornerback *Izaac Swope* and a near 99-yard interception return by opposite corner *Kaiden Patton*. *Sturgell* led LHS with 7 tackles while linebacker *Justin Mustard* matched that number and broke up three passes.

- **Who to watch: St. Charles....** Running back *Fred Nimely* ran for over 200 yards last week in the Cardinals overtime loss to Bishop Watterson. Tight end *Nick Bennison* is an aerial threat who uses his size and athleticism to provide a consistent target for quarterback *Archer Stankowski*.

Defensively St. Charles relies on linebackers *Pete DeSocio*, *Mason O'Reilly*, and *Landon Beverly* to attack the football. *Solomon Lisath* is a disruptor on the defensive line while safety *Aiden Fox* covers a lot of ground in the secondary.

- **Logan against the Diocese ....** This will be Logan's 29<sup>th</sup> game against a school from the Catholic Diocese of Columbus. Logan holds a 15-12-1 overall record in games played against Aquinas College High School (3-2 record), Father Wherle (2-2), Columbus St. Mary's (2-0), Lancaster St. Mary's (5-0-1), St. Francis DeSales (3-7), and Bishop Watterson (0-1). Logan has lost their last five games against central Ohio Catholic competition.
- **Captains ....** Logan's 2021 captains are seniors Keiton Arledge, Carson Hodson, Justin Mustard, and Traten Poling. Poling is the fourth two-time captain in school history joining Anthony Schrader (1920, 21), Dakota Dement (2016, 17), and Jonny McClelland (2019, 20).

Hodson joins his brother Carson (2017) as a full-time captain.

- **On this date ....** Tonight, will be the thirteenth game played by Logan HS on October 1 with the Chiefs holding a 5-7-1 record on the date. The first game was a 0-0 tie against Lancaster in 1927 and they most recently played on October 1 in 2010, a 17-41 loss to Gallipolis. Eleven of the 13 previous games on October 1 have been played on Logan's home field.
