- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight will be the 94th meeting between the Logan Chieftains and the Athens Bulldogs. This ancient rivalry dates back to 1914 and the Bulldogs are Logan's second most played opponent all-time. Logan leads the series 52-36-5.36-5.

Athens looks to rebound from a stunning 50-21 loss to Vinton County on Friday. Athens returned the opening kickoff and led 21-12 in the second quarter before allowing 38 unanswered point in the loss. The Bulldogs were hampered by COVID contact tracing issues the first two weeks of the season and started 0-2. Since getting healthy they lost in overtime to Marietta (28-36) and beat Alexander (41-14).

Logan was handed a disappointing 23-21 loss at Chillicothe last week. The Chieftains led 15-7 and were stopped on a potential game-winning drive in the closing seconds. It was the Chiefs best performance of the season following opening losses to Jackson (7-42), Teays Valley (6-49), and Sheridan (0-33).

- **Celebration of Champions** Tonight Logan HS welcomes back members and coaches from the school's back-to-back 10-0 teams from 2000 and 2001. The team's are marking 20 years since their outstanding seasons – albeit a year late for the 2000 team due to the inability to celebrate last fall due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The teams' will be recognized between the third and fourth quarters.

The 2000 Chieftains went 10-0 in the regular season – including a 62-14 win over Athens – and won the school's first two playoff games against Westerville South (53-20) and Pickerington (28-26) before finishing 12-1 and as regional runners-up.

The 2001 team repeated the 10-0 trick during the regular season – topping Athens 62-16 – and hosted the first a playoff game for the first time. Dublin Coffman – featuring future NFL players Brady Quinn and Nadu Ndukwe – topped Logan 20-14 in a thriller on the old Hilltop field.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Logan's wing-t offense had a break out game at Chillicothe last week – running for 257 yards on 41 attempts and also throwing for 114. Wingback *Traten Poling* has been the featured weapon all season, running for 296 yards and three touchdowns while also catching seven passes for 109 yards and another score. Quarterback *Brayden Sturgell* has gained 120 yards and rushed for a score while completing 17-38 passes for 179 yards and a scoring toss.

Defensively Logan has been up and down this season and are led by linebacker *Justin Mustard's* 28 tackles. Adjustor *Sturgell* and linebacker *Poling* add 27 and 25 tackles respectively. Junior *Izaac Swope* leads the secondary with 22 tackles and an interception.

- **Who to watch: Athens....** Quarterback *Landon Wheatley* has been excellent for the Bulldogs in his three starts. The junior missed the first two games, but since then has completed 39 of 57 passes for 568 yards and six touchdowns against a single interception.

Defensively, the Bulldogs are all seniors up front led by anchored by nose tackle *Ashton Wogerman*. *Luke Brandes* and *Seth Lagraff* are talented linebackers.

- **Captains** Logan's 2021 captains are seniors Keiton Arledge, Carson Hodson, Justin Mustard, and Traten Poling. Poling is the fourth two-time captain in school history joining Anthony Schrader (1920, 21), Dakota Dement (2016, 17), and Jonny McClelland (2019, 20).

Hodson joins his brother Carson (2017) as a full-time captain.

- **On this date** Tonight, will be the sixteenth game played by Logan HS on September 24, 2021 with the Chiefs holding a 10-5 record on the date. The first game was a 10-0 loss to Marietta in 1921 and they most recently played on September 24 in 2010, a 13-0 win over those same Tigers. Logan and Athens have met once on 9/24 – a 52-7 Logan victory in 1999.
