Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the second meeting between the Logan Chieftains and the Minford Falcons, and the Scioto County school's first trip to Logan Chieftain Stadium. Exactly six years ago these two teams played a memorable game that saw Logan complete the largest comeback in school history in a 48-42 double overtime victory. Minford led 35-7 late in the third quarter before the Chieftains scored 28 unanswered points to force overtime. Preston Yates scored in each overtime for Logan.

Minford enters tonight with a 3-3 record and are looking to rebound from consecutive losses against Portsmouth West (7-34) and Waverly (7-33). Their wins came against Rock Hill (17-7), Wellston (42-18), and McDermott Northwest (63-21).

Logan enters tonight's game with a 2-5 record and recorded a bounce back shut out win over Marietta last week. The rebound came after the Chieftains had blown consecutive fourth quarter leads against Athens and Chillicothe.

- **In memory of CD** This season, the Chieftains are wearing special decals on their helmets in memory of longtime Logan sportswriter and Chieftain supporter, Craig Dunn. The decals are a silhouette of Craig's trademark purple hat with the initials "CD" inside. Craig was a 1977 graduate of Logan High School and began covering sports for the Logan Daily News – and later the Logan-Hocking Times – while he was still in high school. Craig passed away suddenly this past spring.
- **Looking for 600** Logan enters tonight with 593 wins in program history and an overall record of 593-434-37. They first played football in 1905. In their history they have also won 26 league championships, qualified for the OHSAA playoffs nine times, and finished with perfect 10-0 regular season records seven times.
- **Celebration of Champions** Tonight, Logan welcomes back players and coaches from 1958, 1978, 1998, 2008, and 2013 football teams. Four of those teams won SEOAL championships while the '78 team is being honored in spite of them losing almost all of their season to a teacher's strike. The 2008 Chieftains opened Logan Chieftain Stadium with a 35-10 win over Lancaster, the first since 1945, and finished with the sixth perfect 10-0 record in school history. They also won the school's first home playoff game when they defeated Dublin Jerome, 23-7.
- **Who to watch: Logan** Senior quarterback *Wyatt Woodgeard* returned to the lineup after sustaining a leg injury in the season opener at Jackson. He ran for 41 yards on 10 carries and scored last week against Marietta. *Chris Gompf* had the Chieftains longest scoring run of the season last week, going for 61-yards on a second quarter touchdown run. Guard *Kallen Wilson* continues to help seal the edge in Logan's outside run game.

Senior linebacker *Jack Brown* leads the team with 57 tackles including five for loss, a sack, a block, and eight quarterback pressures. End *Maddox Arnett* has been the most disruptive Chieftain, recording four tackles for loss and three sacks amongst his 46 total stops. Safety *Jeremy Fraley* has made an interception in each of the last three weeks and has caused three fumbles and broken up three passes.

- **Who to watch: Minford....** The Falcons are multiple on offense, but are built around talented sophomore quarterback *Peyton Caudill* and senior running back *Jeffrey Pica*. Caudill has sprinter speed and was a state qualifier in the 200m last spring as a freshman while Pica has size and speed to beat teams inside and outside. Tackles *Blake Skeens* and *Owen Blaine* anchor the offensive line. They average over 26 points per game.

Defensively the Falcons are yielding 22.5 points per game and line-up in a 4-3 base defense. *JD Matiz* plays a monster role as the outside linebacker with *Randall Schreick* playing inside. Up front Minford starts four seniors led by *Blaine* and *Wesley Zimmerman*. *Mason Book* plays cornerback.

- **Ohio Capital Conference** Logan has been independent since the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League dissolved following the 2016-17 school year. Logan was a member of the SEOAL, which was founded in 1925, for its entire existence.

Logan will be joining the OCC-Buckeye division in 2024-25 along with Canal Winchester, Groveport-Madison, Lancaster, Newark, Pickerington Central, Reynoldsburg, and Teays Valley.

- **Captains** Logan's 2023 captains are seniors Jack Brown, Lucas Wolfe, and Wyatt Woodgeard along with juniors Jack Walsh and Kallen Wilson. All but Brown are legacy Chieftains – their fathers all played at LHS.

Walsh and Wilson are just the fifth and sixth underclassmen to serve as captains. Walsh joins his father, Pat, and brothers, Brady and Quinn, who previously served as captains.

- **On this date** Tonight, will be the thirteenth game ever played by LHS on September 29th with the Chiefs holding an 11-2 record on the date. Logan first played on October 6 way back in 1906, a 40-0 win over Nelsonville. Logan has played Marietta three times on this date, winning in 1995 (28-0), 2000 (48-0), and 2006 (41-0).
