Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the 101st meeting between Jackson and Logan in a series that dates back to 1906. The Ironmen hold a 50-46-4 advantage thanks in large part to a decade of dominance that has seen them win nine of ten meetings including the last seven games. Logan last won in 2013.

Jackson is coming off an outstanding season that saw them win 10 games for a second straight season, including a pair of playoff victories. They finished 10-3 with all three losses coming by a combined six points. They were champions of the Frontier Athletic Conference for the second straight fall.

Logan finished the 2022 season with a 4-6 record and were a two-point conversion stop at Buckeye Valley away from their first .500 season since the team finished 8-2 in 2015.

- **Opening night jinx** Over the last 22 seasons the Chieftains are a dismal 4-18 in season openers. On the bright side, three of those four season opening wins ended in perfect 10-0 regular seasons.

Logan defeated New Lexington 13-12 in 2001, Lancaster in 2008 (35-10) and 2009 (33-14) and beat Athens 62-49 in 2015. In between those victories were losses to New Lex and Westerville South; nine losses to Lancaster; three to the Ironmen, and two each against Dublin Jerome and Tri-Valley.

- **Looking for 600** Logan enters the 2023 with 591 wins in program history and an overall record of 591-430-37. They first played football in 1905. In their history they have also won 26 league championships, qualified for the OHSAA playoffs nine times, and finished with perfect 10-0 regular season records seven times.
- **Common foe** Jackson and Logan are longtime rivals, meeting 100 times on the gridiron since 1906. Jackson leads the all-time series 50-46-4. Both schools were founding members of the SEOAL with Logan winning a record 26 titles and Jackson winning 25.

Jackson is Logan's most played opponent while Jackson has only faced Wellston more in their football history.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Offensively, Logan will transition from an under center wing-t to a spread wing-t that will ask quarterback *Wyatt Woodgeard* to be more dynamic. Running back *Kaden Morgan* is Logan's top statistical returner on offense while *Kallen Wilson* and *Aiden Hite* will anchor the offensive line.

Logan made a leap defensively in 2022, but return only three starters on that side of the ball and must completely rebuild their secondary. Fortunately, senior *Jack Brown* returns after leading the team in tackles and sacks. Up front, *Wilson* was a consistent presence. *Jack Walsh* is the emotional leader.

- **Who to watch: Jackson** The Apple Citizens will utilize a power running game featuring *Cade Wolford*, *Eli Broermann*, and *Nolan Johnson*. Wolford's younger brother, *Bodhi*, will take over the quarterback role.

Jackson will play aggressive, fast, and physical on defense thanks to a linebacking corps. that features *Johnson*, *Gaven Jones*, and *Zander Ervin*. In the secondary, *Broerman* and *Cade Wolford* are disruptors. Up front, *Mike Baker* is a returning starter.

- **Captains** Logan's 2023 captains are seniors Jack Brown, Lucas Wolfe, and Wyatt Woodgeard along with juniors Jack Walsh and Kallen Wilson. All but Brown are legacy Chieftains – their fathers all played at LHS.

Walsh and Wilson are just the fifth and sixth underclassmen to serve as captains. Walsh joins his father, Pat, and brother, Brady, who previously served as captains.

- **On this date** Tonight will match the earliest opener in school history. Logan and Jackson opened each of the last two seasons on August 19 with Jackson prevailing 42-7 in 2021 and 35-7 in 2022. The previous earliest start dates came on Aug. 22 in both 2003 (0-29 loss at Westerville South) and 2008 (35-10 win over Lancaster).
