- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the 99th all-time meeting between the Athens Bulldogs and the Logan Chieftains. Logan leads the all-time series, which started in 1907, 54-39-5. The two were Southeastern Ohio Athletic League members from 1925-2007 (Athens left the league from 1928-1930) but didn't play between 2008 and 2014 following the Bulldogs departure from the league. Since the rivalry renewed in 2015, Logan leads 5-2 including wins in the last three meetings. Logan won last fall 35-13.

With Logan joining the Ohio Capital Conference in 2024, this is the last scheduled meeting for the foreseeable future.

Athens enters tonight with a 1-4 record. They lost their first three games to Philo (13-28), Gallipolis (0-30), and Marietta (19-28) but rebounded to beat Alexander (55-7) to open Tri-Valley Conference Ohio Division play. The Bulldogs lost 35-13 to conference co-favorite Vinton County last week in a game that was much closer than the final score would indicate.

Logan enters tonight's game with a 1-4 record. The Chieftains also started 0-3 falling to Jackson (0-22), Teays Valley (6-28), and Sheridan (10-41) before beating Warren (20-14). Last week, Logan lost in heartbreaking fashion to Chillicothe (17-14). The Chieftains led 14-3 with eight minutes to play before mistakes in all three phases allowed the Cavalier comeback.

- **In memory of CD** This season, the Chieftains are wearing special decals on their helmets in memory of longtime Logan sportswriter and Chieftain supporter, Craig Dunn. The decals are a silhouette of Craig's trademark purple hat with the initials "CD" inside. Craig was a 1977 graduate of Logan High School and began covering sports for the Logan Daily News – and later the Logan-Hocking Times – while he was still in high school. Craig passed away suddenly this past spring.
- **Looking for 600** Logan enters tonight with 592 wins in program history and an overall record of 592-433-37. They first played football in 1905. In their history they have also won 26 league championships, qualified for the OHSAA playoffs nine times, and finished with perfect 10-0 regular season records seven times.
- **Common foe** Logan and Athens have met 98 times on the gridiron, the Chieftains second most common opponent. Below is a list of Logan's most played football opponents:

- **Who to watch: Logan** *Kaden Morgan* again led the Chieftains with 111 rushing yards and a touchdown on 23 attempts last week, his second straight 100-yard effort, and has now gained 342 yards on 78 carries for the season. Freshman quarterback *Carson Tootle* completed 6 of 14 passes for 121 yards including a 62 yards scoring toss to *Jeremy Fraley*. *Fraley* made 3 catches for 94 yards. *Kallen Wilson* led the way on the perimeter from his guard position.

Linebacker *Jack Brown* led the Chieftains with 10 tackles and blocked a field goal last week. The senior leads the team with 38 total stops this season. *Fraley* added an interception and broke up a pass while *Wilson* recorded a pair of pressures and made a tackle for loss.

- **Who to watch: Athens....** *Alex Pero* leads the Bulldogs with 536 yards rushing and five touchdowns on 104 carries. Quarterback *Braeden Young* is a dual threat passing for 647 yards (43-72) with four touchdowns and three interceptions while also running for 102 yards on 63 attempts. *Leo Martin* has made 19 catches for 290 yards with a pair of touchdown catches.

Defensively *Wylie Anderson* and *Isaiah Roberts* lead a stout three man defensive line while *Seth Hart* is a physical downhill inside linebacker. *Pero* and *Martin* are active in the secondary.

- **Ohio Capital Conference** Logan has been independent since the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League dissolved following the 2016-17 school year. Logan was a member of the SEOAL, which was founded in 1925, for its entire existence.

Logan will be joining the OCC-Buckeye division in 2024-25 along with Canal Winchester, Groveport-Madison, Lancaster, Newark, Pickerington Central, Reynoldsburg, and Teays Valley

- **Captains** Logan's 2023 captains are seniors Jack Brown, Lucas Wolfe, and Wyatt Woodgeard along with juniors Jack Walsh and Kallen Wilson. All but Brown are legacy Chieftains – their fathers all played at LHS.

Walsh and Wilson are just the fifth and sixth underclassmen to serve as captains. Walsh joins his father, Pat, and brothers, Brady and Quinn, who previously served as captains.

- **On this date** Tonight, will be the thirteenth game ever played by LHS on September 22nd with the Chiefs holding a 5-8 record on the date. Logan first played on September 22 in 1922, an 18-0 win over Bremen and most recently played on the date in 2017, a 43-21 loss to Chillicothe.
