Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the twenty seventh all-time meeting between the Zanesville Blue Devils and the Logan Chieftains. The series, which ZHS leads 15-11, has been marked by streaks. Zanesville won the first nine game from 1923-1998, then Logan won ten straight from 1999-2009, and the Blue Devils won the next six from 2010-2021. Logan won last season for the first time 2009.

Zanesville enters tonight with a 1-8 record, their only win coming against Hebron Lakewood back in week four, a 22-16 double overtime victory. The Blue Devils lost to rival Newark for the first time since 2016 in the season opener and have struggled against their Licking County League rivals.

Logan enters tonight's game with a 2-7 record and is coming off another loss where they led in the second half. The Chieftains led Fort Frye 14-7 midway through the third quarter before falling 26-14. Logan's wins came over Warren 20-14 and Marietta 17-0.

- **In memory of CD** This season, the Chieftains are wearing special decals on their helmets in memory of longtime Logan sportswriter and Chieftain supporter, Craig Dunn. The decals are a silhouette of Craig's trademark purple hat with the initials "CD" inside. Craig was a 1977 graduate of Logan High School and began covering sports for the Logan Daily News – and later the Logan-Hocking Times – while he was still in high school. Craig passed away suddenly this past spring.
- **Looking for 600** Logan enters tonight with 593 wins in program history and an overall record of 593-436-37. They first played football in 1905. In their history they have also won 26 league championships, qualified for the OHSAA playoffs nine times, and finished with perfect 10-0 regular season records seven times.
- **Who to watch: Logan** Junior running back *Kaden Morgan* leads Logan with 693 yards rushing and three touchdowns on 149 carries and has also caught eight passes for 77 yards. His 80-yard touchdown run at Fort Frye last week was the team's longest play from scrimmage this season. Senior quarterback Wyatt Woodgeard has passed for 144 yards on 19 of 43 passing and ran for 131 yards and two touchdowns. Seniors *Aiden Hite* and *Avery Linton* help anchor the offensive line.

Senior linebacker *Jack Brown* leads the team with 71 total tackles including seven for loss, one sack, and eight quarterback pressures. Junior end *Maddox Arnett* has a team high three sacks amongst his 58 stops. Junior tackle *Kallen Wilson* led LHS last week with eight stops and a sack. Defensive backs *Jacob Kahrig* and *Jeremy Fraley* lead the team with three interceptions each.

- **Who to watch: Zanesville....** Offensively, *Kamarion Ruff* has run for 247 yards on 61 carries while *Makhi Murray* adds 552 passing yards on 70-150 passing. *Drake Tabler* is a top pass catcher with 14 receptions for 142 yards and a touchdown. Up front, tackle *Noah Corbin*, center *Joseph Baker*, and guard *Canon Mercer* anchor a physical front.

Defensively the Blue Devil defensive line is led by *Mercer* and end *Tre Bradford*. Linebacker *Vaughn Pouncy* leads the team with 53 tackles. Defensive back *David Evans* and *Tabler* lead the team with three interceptions each.

Do-it-all senior *Drew Doyle* is questionable for tonight's game, but leads the team with 431 rushing yards, adds 112 receiving yards, and has the co-lead for interceptions with three. Doyle has scored nine of the teams 11 touchdowns despite missing the last two weeks.

- **Ohio Capital Conference** Logan has been independent since the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League dissolved following the 2016-17 school year. Logan was a member of the SEOAL, which was founded in 1925, for its entire existence.

Logan will be joining the OCC-Buckeye division in 2024-25 along with Canal Winchester, Groveport-Madison, Lancaster, Newark, Pickerington Central, Reynoldsburg, and Teays Valley.

- **Captains** Logan's 2023 captains are seniors Jack Brown, Lucas Wolfe, and Wyatt Woodgeard along with juniors Jack Walsh and Kallen Wilson. All but Brown are legacy Chieftains – their fathers all played at LHS.

Walsh and Wilson are just the fifth and sixth underclassmen to serve as captains. Walsh joins his father, Pat, and brothers, Brady and Quinn, who previously served as captains.

- **On this date** Tonight, will be the fifteenth game ever played by LHS on October 20 with the Chiefs holding a 10-3-1 record on the date. Logan first played on this date in 1906, a 210-0 win at Nelsonville and most recently lost at Hamilton Ross, 33-21, in 2017. Logan has played Jackson six times on this date with the Chiefs holding a 4-2 record in those games. Memorably, 23 years ago the Chieftains crushed Jackson 62-14 in 2000 on their way to a 10-0 regular season.
