Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight, Logan and Sheridan play for the sixth time – and last time under current contract. With Logan joining the Ohio Capital Conference in 2024, they will have only three nonconference slots to fill. The Generals have won all five prior matchups and won 28-7 last season.

Sheridan finished 11-2 last fall and finished as the regional runner-up in Division III, Region 11 and as champions of the Muskingum Valley League. So far in 2022 the Generals are 2-0 with wins over Licking Valley (33-14) and Watkins Memorial (24-19).

Logan finished the 2022 season with a 4-6 record and was a two-point conversion stop at Buckeye Valley away from their first .500 season since the team finished 8-2 in 2015. Logan has started the season 0-2 with losses at Jackson (0-22) and Teays Valley (6-28).

- **Logan HS Athletic Hall of Fame** Tonight the three newest inductees to the Logan HS Athletic Hall of Fame will be recognized during a pregame ceremony. The Hall of Fame was established in 1976 to honor former LHS graduates, graduates of high schools now consolidated with the Logan-Hocking School District, and coaches for their contribution and participation in athletics and coaching.

The 2023 class includes Tiger Veidt (LHS 1982), Jamey Hankison (LHS '01), and Michael Angle (LHS '08). Veidt was a baseball standout who has gone on to be one of the top prep baseball coaches in Ohio at Whiteoak High School, Hankison was a fullback-linebacker on Logan's regional finalist squad from 2000, and Angle is the only quarterback in the entire history of the SEOAL to start three years at quarterback and never lose a league game.

- **There's a first for everything** Tonight, freshman Carson Tootle is expected to start at quarterback for the Chieftains. He would become the first freshman to start a game at quarterback in the history of LHS football and last week became just the third freshman to ever complete a pass during a Varsity football game joining current LHS Athletic Director Keith Myers (freshman in 1982) and Braden Spatar (freshman in 2016).
- **In memory of CD** This season, the Chieftains are wearing special decals on their helmet in memory of longtime Logan sportswriter and Chieftain supporter, Craig Dunn. The decals are a silhouette of Craig's trademark purple hat with the initials "CD" inside. Craig was a 1977 graduate of Logan High School and began covering sports for the Logan Daily News – and later the Logan-Hocking Times – while he was still in high school. Craig passed away suddenly this past spring.
- **Looking for 600** Logan enters tonight with 591 wins in program history and an overall record of 591-431-37. They first played football in 1905. In their history they have also won 26 league championships, qualified for the OHSAA playoffs nine times, and finished with perfect 10-0 regular season records seven times.

- **Ohio Capital Conference** Logan has been independent since the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League dissolved following the 2016-17 school year. Logan was a member of the SEOAL, which was founded in 1925, for its entire existence.

Logan will be joining the OCC-Buckeye division along with Canal Winchester, Groveport-Madison, Lancaster, Newark, Pickerington Central, Reynoldsburg, and Teays Valley

- **Who to watch: Logan** Logan got off to a fast start last week when *Jack Walsh* connected with tight end *Lucas Wolfe* for 51 yards to set up an early go-ahead touchdown, but the offense bogged down after that opening drive. Freshman *Carson Tootle* completed three passes to *Walsh* late in the game as Logan tried desperately to get back in the football game.

Defensively Logan had another solid outing – allowing only 14 points to Teays Valley with the Vikings also adding a pair of defensive touchdowns. End *Maddox Arnett*, tackle *Elijah Yates*, and linebacker *Jack Brown* all led the team with 7 tackles a week ago.

- **Who to watch: Sheridan** Generals quarterback *Caden Sheridan* is a true dual threat leading the Generals with 237 passing yards (16-33, three touchdowns) and 154 rushing yards (32 carries, three touchdowns). *Justin Munyan* is a quick, powerful runner who has gained 150 yards and scored twice on 33 attempts.

Defensively, Sheridan is excellent out of their 3-3 stack defense. The forward line is anchored by *Hunter Sites* while *Munyan* and *Ben Fox* set the tone from the dual strong safety slots. *AJ Winder* is a strong tackler from his corner post.

- **Captains** Logan's 2023 captains are seniors Jack Brown, Lucas Wolfe, and Wyatt Woodgeard along with juniors Jack Walsh and Kallen Wilson. All but Brown are legacy Chieftains – their fathers all played at LHS.

Walsh and Wilson are just the fifth and sixth underclassmen to serve as captains. Walsh joins his father, Pat, and brother, Brady, who previously served as captains.

- **On this date** Tonight will be the seventh game ever played by LHS on September 1st with the Chiefs holding a 2-3-1 record on the date. Logan first played on Sept. 1 in 1978, a 0-0 tie with New Lexington. Logan defeated Nelsonville-York 6-0 on this date in 1989 – the first overtime game in school history.
