Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the 21st meeting between Zanesville and Logan with the all time series knotted up at 10 wins apiece. The two schools first played in 1923, but would not meet again until 1991 when former LHS grid-boss Clarence Perry brought his Blue Devils to Logan and escaped with a 14-13 win. Including the win in 1923, ZHS won the first nine meetings before Logan got its first win in 1999, a 20-14 win in overtime. Logan won 10 straight games from 1999-2009, with the two teams not playing in 2003. Zanesville won in 2010 and this is the first meeting since then.

Zanesville is 7-0, including 3-0 in the ECOL and ranked third in the latest Associated Press Division II statewide poll. The Blue Devils have defeated traditional Muskingum Valley League powers Sheridan (49-7) and Tri Valley (52-7) as well as ECOL powers Dover (35-14) and New Philadelphia (28-14). Dover had not lost an ECOL game since 2006.

Logan opened the season with losses to Lancaster (7-57) and Teays Valley (13-26), defeated Newark (32-27), and lost to Loudonville (31-7) before recording its first three game winning streak since 2009 with wins over Nelsonville-York (14-12), Portsmouth (54-27), and Jackson (28-21). Logan will have an opportunity to clinch a share of their first SEOAL championship since 2009 next week at Gallipolis.

- **Next on the list, a playoff win....** Since Chad Grandstaff became head coach of the Blue Devils in 2007, Zanesville has been an impressive 53-17 overall including three trips to the postseason. With a first league championship all but wrapped up, next on the list for Grandstaff and his coaching staff is an elusive win in the playoffs. Zanesville is 1-5 all-time in the playoffs with their lone win coming in 1997. Also, despite nine wins in three of the last four seasons, Zanesville has the opportunity for a perfect 10-0 regular season for the first time in a couple of decades.
- **From Home standers to Road Warriors** Logan has played five of their first seven games of the 2013 season at Logan Chieftain Stadium, but will finish the year with two of their last three away from home. In fact, eight of the Chieftains next 13 games will be played outside of Hocking County.
- **All-Time Wins** While Zanesville celebrated a milestone with their 600th win in school history by beating Dover two weeks ago, Logan is nearing a milestone of their own according to the latest research compiled by LoganFootball.com. Logan won their 546th game since football was recognized as a Varsity sport at Logan High School in 1912, meaning that the Chieftains could pass 550 all-time wins as soon as the season opener against Lancaster in 2014.
- **Meet the new boss** Logan's Billy Burke was named the school's 30th head football coach during the off-season. Burke is a graduate of Lancaster High School and played football at the University of Akron. Burke previously coached as an assistant at Hilliard Darby and was the head coach at Buckeye High School in Medina County.
- **SEOAL** The Chieftains are founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, and have been members continuously since 1925. Logan, winners of more titles (25) than any school in the history of the league, will compete with Gallia Academy, Jackson, Portsmouth, and Warren for the championship. Jackson is second to Logan with 22 SEOAL championships.

A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Gallipolis as the favorite to repeat as Champions after the Blue Devils 5-0 league record in 2011. Logan was picked to finish third behind the Jackson Ironmen and just ahead of Warren and Portsmouth.

Zanesville was a member of the SEOAL from 2006-2008.
