Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight marks the 91st meeting (since 1912) between Jackson and Logan, two of the founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League. Jackson passed Athens, who left the SEOAL following the 2007 season, as the most-played opponent in LHS history. Logan leads the all-time series 45-41-4 since football became a recognized Varsity sport at Logan in 1912. Jackson has won the last three meetings.

Jackson opened the 2013 campaign with resounding 54-18 and 68-0 wins over Wellston and Waverly respectively, but then lost three straight to West Jefferson (7-42), Athens (0-49), and Wheelersburg (14-49). Jackson bounced back to open up their SEOAL campaign by beating Warren 35-20 last week in Washington County.

Logan opened the season with losses to Lancaster (7-57) and Teays Valley (13-26), defeated Newark (32-27), and lost to Loudonville (31-7) before recording back-to-back wins over Nelsonville-York (14-12) and Portsmouth (54-27).

- **2012 Meeting** Jackson withstood a frantic fourth quarter comeback by Logan to record a 31-20 win over the Chieftains. Jackson used its power running game to take a 31-6 lead, but a pair of long touchdown passes from Jack Music to Donnie Stevens cut the Jackson lead to 31-20 midway through the fourth quarter. Four different backs scored TDs for Jackson and Jimmy Voiles kicked a 41-yard field goal.
- **Offense produces** Last week the Logan Chieftain offense produced at record levels – Isaac Schmeltzer (11 carries) and Bryce McBride (8 carries) each ran for 223 yards, the first time two Chieftain backs ever eclipsed 200-yards in the same game. Logan's 562 rushing yards were a school record. Schmeltzer's five touchdowns tied for second all-time at LHS.
- **Only three things happen when you throw the ball** Logan did not attempt a pass until the third quarter against the Trojans last week. In the 2012 game against Portsmouth, Logan did not attempt a pass the entire game, making it a six-quarter streak without a pass attempt against PHS. The score over those six quarters? Logan 68, Portsmouth 19.
- **That's called a winning streak** Logan (3-3) is off to their best start to a season since starting 5-0 in both 2008 and 2009. Logan started 0-5 each of the last two seasons. After defeating Nelsonville-York and Portsmouth the last two weeks, Logan can win a third straight game for the first time since the 2009 season.
- **Meet the new boss** Logan's Billy Burke was named the school's 30th head football coach during the off-season. Burke is a graduate of Lancaster High School and played football at the University of Akron. Burke previously coached as an assistant at Hilliard Darby and was the head coach at Buckeye High School in Medina County.
- **SEOAL** The Chieftains are founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, and have been members continuously since 1925. Logan, winners of more titles than any school in the history of the league, will compete with Gallia Academy, Jackson, Portsmouth, and Warren for the championship. Jackson is second to Logan with 22 SEOAL championships.

A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Gallipolis as the favorite to repeat as Champions after the Blue Devils 5-0 league record in 2011. Logan was picked to finish third behind the Jackson Ironmen and just ahead of Warren and Portsmouth.
