## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Portsmouth and Logan High Schools meet tonight at Logan Chieftain Stadium for the 9<sup>th</sup> time with the series square at four wins each. Portsmouth, a founding member of the SEOAL, left the league after the 1927 season and the two teams did not meet again until 2006.

Curtis Clifford, a 30+ year veteran of the Trojan sidelines, retired after last season. Jason Sparks has led PHS to a 2-3 record in his first year including a huge win over rival Ironton last week (33-20). The Trojans also defeated Portsmouth West (35-21) while losing to Lucasville Valley (28-19), Wheelersburg (42-14), and Minford (34-6).

Like Portsmouth, Logan recorded a huge road victory over a rival last week, beating Nelsonville-York 14-12. The Chieftains also defeated Newark (32-27) but lost games to Lancaster (57-7), Teays Valley (26-13), and Loudonville (31-7).

- **2012 Meeting ....** Logan defeated Portsmouth 34-13 at the Trojan Coliseum in Portsmouth, recording their first win of the season. Logan did not attempt a single pass due to quarterback Jack Music missing the game because of an injury. Sophomore QB Caleb Lewellen started the game, and handed the ball off to Cory McCarty again and again as the senior tailback ran for 270 yards and 3 touchdowns on 39 carries. Alex Dickerson caught three passes for 91 yards and two touchdowns for the Trojans.
- **Best start since 2009 ....** Logan is off to their best start to a season since starting 5-0 in both 2008 and 2009. Logan started 0-5 each of the last two seasons before picking up their first win the next week and were 0-4 in 2010 before beating Marietta in week 5. The Chieftains two non-league wins this season are their first since 2009.
- **2012 Round Up ....** Logan lost a pair of hard breaking non-league games against Northland (26-32, overtime) and Newark (32-35) and had a pair of embarrassing losses to close the non-league (Nelsonville-York, 50-0) and league (Warren, 49-8) seasons. The Chieftains ended up the season 2-8 overall with a pair of SEOAL wins over Portsmouth (35-14) and Chillicothe (28-7). Running back Cory McCarty was a third team All-Ohio selection despite battling injuries the second half of the season.

Portsmouth failed to win an SEOAL game in Curtis Clifford's final season and limped to a 1-9 record. Their lone win was a 21-18 triumph over Portsmouth West.

- **Meet the new boss ....** Logan's Bill Burke was named the school's 30<sup>th</sup> head football coach during the off-season. Burke is a graduate of Lancaster High School and played football at the University of Akron. Burke previously coached as an assistant at Hilliard Darby and was the head coach at Buckeye High School in Medina County.
- **SEOAL ....** The Chieftains are founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, and have been members continuously since 1925. Logan, winners of more titles than any school in the history of the league, will compete with Gallia Academy, Jackson, Portsmouth, and Warren for the championship.

A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Gallipolis as the favorite to repeat as Champions after the Blue Devils 5-0 league record in 2011. Logan was picked to finish third behind the Jackson Ironmen and just ahead of Warren and Portsmouth.
