### **Game Notes:**

Tonight's Match-up .... Tonight marks the 28<sup>th</sup> meeting all-time between Warren and Logan with the Chieftains holding a 22-5 overall record. The Warriors have won in each of the last two seasons. The Warriors and Chieftains met for the first time in 1986 when Warren joined the SEOAL, and the two teams have met every season since. Only Gallipolis has appeared on Logan's schedule for more consecutive seasons.

Logan clinched a share of their first SEOAL championship since 2009 last week at Gallipolis, but need a win tonight to ensure an outright championship. It marks Logan's 26<sup>th</sup> football championship, tops among SEOAL members. Logan is 5-4 overall with non-league wins over Newark (32-27) and Nelsonville-York (14-12). Logan did not have a losing season from 1998-2009 but will snap a threeyear losing streak this fall.

Warren is probably disappointed with their 3-6 record, but most disappointed with their 1-2 mark in the SEOAL. After defeating Gallipolis 31-21 two weeks ago, the Warriors were a win over Portsmouth from competing for a share of the SEOAL championship tonight. Warren has only one SEOAL championship (1995) in history. Warren lost at home 26-12 against Portsmouth last week.

- Last Year's Match-Up .... Warren ran up their largest win ever against Logan in a 49-8 beat down at Warren's stadium. It marked a second straight season in which Warren scored 40 or more points joining 2011's 40-34 double overtime victory. Warren has only scored more than 20 points five times against Logan and won all five games. Warren finished the season 4-6 while Logan fell to 2-8.
- All-Time wins milestone within sight .... Logan is nearing an all-time wins milestone according to the latest research compiled by LoganFootball.com. Logan won their 547<sup>th</sup> game since football was recognized as a Varsity sport at Logan High School in 1912, meaning that the Chieftains could reach 550 all-time wins as soon as next season.
- Meet the new boss .... Logan's Billy Burke was named the school's 30th head football coach during the off-season. Burke is a graduate of Lancaster High School and played football at the University of Akron. Burke previously coached as an assistant at Hilliard Darby and was the head coach at Buckeye High School in Medina County.
- SEOAL .... The Chieftains are founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, and have been members continuously since 1925. Logan, winners of more titles (25) than any school in the history of the league, will compete with Gallia Academy, Jackson, Portsmouth, and Warren for the championship. Jackson is second to Logan with 22 SEOAL championships.

A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Gallipolis as the favorite to repeat as Champions after the Blue Devils 5-0 league record in 2011. Logan was picked to finish third behind the Jackson Ironmen and just ahead of Warren and Portsmouth.

Never too early .... Logan's 2014 football schedule has been finalized. The season will kick off on on Aug. 29 with a home game against Lancaster, followed by trips to Teays Valley (first ever), Meigs (first since 1982), and Loudonville (first ever). The Chiefs will return home to face Nelsonville-York in week five, visit Portsmouth and Jackson to open SEOAL play, host Zanesville and Gallipolis, before finishing at Warren.
