Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Logan travels to Loudonville for the second part of a home and home series with the Redbirds. It is Logan's second-ever trip to Ashland County having previously played a home and home series with Ashland High School in 1987 and 1988. Logan recorded their first victory of the season last week, demolishing Meigs 55-7. The Chieftains were hard-luck losers the first two weeks falling 43-42 in double overtime against Lancaster in week one and 44-40 to Teays Valley in week two. Loudonville has run roughshod over the competition so far in 2014, racking 155 points while allowing only 14. The Redbirds have recorded back to back shut out victories.
- **2013 Round Up** First year head coach Billy Burke brought a new attitude to Logan Chieftain Stadium, daring the Chieftains to "Restore Order" – declaring the intent to return discipline, expectations, and a winning attitude to the sideline. Despite an 1-3 start, Logan won 5 of their final six games on their way to securing the school's 26th SEOAL football championship.

Loudonville were playoff qualifiers for the third straight season and reached the second round with a 20-8 victory over Northwestern. Overall the 'Birds finished 10-2.

- **Legendary coach was a Redbird** Despite being just the second ever meeting between the two schools, Loudonville and Logan share one key connection. Tom Bender, coach of the Chieftains from 1936-1941, was a native of Loudonville and graduated from Ashland College in 1929. Bender was an inaugural inductee into the LHS Athletic Hall of Fame in 1976. Bender compiled a 38-18-1 record, won a pair of SEOAL championships (1939, 1941), and coached Logan's first two HM All-Ohio football players Bob McBride (1939) and Bill "Mutt" Bryan (1940).
- **All-Time wins milestone within sight** Logan is nearing an all-time wins milestone according to the latest research compiled by LoganFootball.com. Logan won their 549th game since football was recognized as a Varsity sport at Logan High School in 1912 with their victory over Meigs last week, meaning that the Chieftains next victory would mark the 550th of all-time.
- **Off the carpet....** This is the third consecutive week that will see Logan playing on real grass. Since moving to Logan Chieftain Stadium in 2008, and the artificial playing surface that came with it, Logan has only played on real grass in back-to-back weeks twice and have not played three straight games on real grass since playing all eleven on grass in 2007.
- **SEOAL** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the SEOAL championship after a runner-up finish to Logan last season. The Ironmen return 21 of 24 starters after a 6-4 (3-1) finish in 2013. Logan was slotted as the runner-up, with Portsmouth third, Gallipolis fourth, and Warren fifth.
