Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the 82nd meeting all-time between Gallipolis and Logan, a pair of long time SEOAL rivals. Logan leads the all-time series by the tightest of margins with a 41-40-1 record. The Blue Devils have recorded consecutive SEOAL wins over Portsmouth (24-15) and Warren (20-6) and are 4-4 overall. Logan is 3-5 (1-1) and has lost their last two games, a 42-7 loss against SEOAL-leading Jackson and a 24-14 loss here against Zanesville last week.
- **Home sweet home** Logan is back at home for a two-game home stand following consecutive road trips to Portsmouth and Jackson in SEOAL play. The Chieftains have been road warriors in 2014, playing on the road six times including trips to Loudonville, Portsmouth, Meigs, and in two weeks to Warren.
- **Murderer's Row** Logan and Gallipolis have combined for 9 losses, but seven of those nine-teams are well positioned to appear in the state playoffs in two weeks. Gallipolis has lost to a pair of undefeated teams in Athens and arch-rival Point Pleasant (WV) while a third loss came against Kentucky state-power Belfry who is 7-1. The Blue Devils will host 8-0 Jackson next Friday night to conclude their season.

Logan has lost to a pair of undefeated teams in Loudonville and Jackson with Teays Valley sitting at 6-2 and virtually assured of a playoff spot. Lancaster, who defeated the Chieftains in week one, need a little help but sit at 5-3 overall and 2-2 in the rugged OCC-Ohio.

- **Moving on up** Lane Little continues to climb the LHS top ten lists, where he now sits sixth in passing yards in a season with 1,325 trailing Patrick Angle in 2008-2009, Joey Conrad in 1999-2000, and Chad Zimmerman in 1994. The school record of 2,546 yards should be safe for another year.

Little is also eight for pass attempts in a season with 178, seventh in pass completions with 95, and eighth in touchdown passes with 13.

Chieftain receiver Chance Cox currently sits tied for ninth for pass receptions in a season with 36, needing two more catches to tie his father Eric for eight on the list. Junior Isaiah Smith has caught at least one pass in 14 straight games, good enough for third on the all-time list and is also tied for ninth with six touchdown receptions this season.

- **A shutout "shutout"** With Zanesville's 24-14 win over the Chieftains last week, Logan's record streak without recording a shut-out stretched to 43 games. Logan last recorded a shut-out against Marietta in 2010. The two previous record stretches without recording a shut-out were from 2003-2006 (35 games) and from 1982-1985 (28 games).
- **SEOAL** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the SEOAL championship after a runner-up finish to Logan last season. The Ironmen return 21 of 24 starters after a 6-4 (3-1) finish in 2013. Logan was slotted as the runner-up, with Portsmouth third, Gallipolis fourth, and Warren fifth.
