## **Game Notes:**

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight marks the final scheduled appearance between Logan and Lancaster on the gridiron. For the US33 rivals, separated by only 20 miles, the last 11 season openers have been memorable. While the Fairfield Countians have dominated the series, winning of 8 of 10 games since the series renewed in 2004 and 32 of 44 meetings all time, Logan's wins in 2008 and 2009 sparked historic seasons. Logan and Lancaster both are searching for their first postseason appearances since 2009. Logan will replace Lancaster with long-time rival Athens beginning in 2015.
- **2013 Meeting ....** Logan took a 7-0 lead after Lancaster committed three turnovers in the game's opening nine minutes, but Logan's defense never looked like stopping the Gales' wing-t offense. In fact, the Lancasterians ran for an opponent record 518 yards on their way to 57 unanswered points and a 57-7 victory. To make matters worse, sophomore quarterback Lane Little was lost for virtually the entire season when he broke his collarbone in the third quarter.
- **2013 Round Up ....** First year head coach Billy Burke brought a new attitude to Logan Chieftain Stadium, daring the Chieftains to "Restore Order" – declaring the intent to return discipline, expectations, and a winning attitude to the sideline. Despite an 1-3 start, Logan won 5 of their final six games on their way to securing the school's 26<sup>th</sup> SEOAL football championship.

Lancaster overcame a shocking amount of injuries, and hosted Newark on the last day of the regular season with a chance to clinch a winning record. The winless Wildcats upset a satisfied Lancaster team, dooming the Gales to a .500 finish. An identical schedule awaits the Gales in 2014 as they search for a return to the OHSAA playoffs.

- **All-Time wins milestone within sight ....** Logan is nearing an all-time wins milestone according to the latest research compiled by LoganFootball.com. Logan won their 548<sup>th</sup> game since football was recognized as a Varsity sport at Logan High School in 1912, meaning that the Chieftains could reach 550 all-time wins as soon as next season.
- **Lucky Number 7? ....** For the 11<sup>th</sup> time in 16 years, the starting quarterback for the Chieftains will be wearing number seven. Joey Conrad began the streak as a sophomore in 1998, wearing the number through the 2000 season. In 2001 and 2002 Alex Penrod and David Ellis wore numbers 23 and 8 respectively, before a run of seven straight seasons of number seven. Corey Spackey, Michael Angle, and Patrick Angle all donned the numeral until Jordan Jurgensmier sported number 17 in his lone season as signal caller. Both Jack Music (#35 to #7) and Lane Little (#12 to #7) changed their number following their sophomore seasons.
- **SEOAL ....** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the SEOAL championship after a runner-up finish to Logan last season. The Ironmen return 21 of 24 starters after a 6-4 (3-1) finish in 2013. Logan was slotted as the runner-up, with Portsmouth third, Gallipolis fourth, and Warren fifth.
