Game Notes:

- Tonight's Match-up Logan makes their first ever trip to Teays Valley to take on the 1-0 Vikings. TVHS routed county rival Westfall 49-0 in their season opener away from home. Mark Weber is in his first season in charge of the Vikings. Logan were 43-42 losers in double overtime in the final scheduled meeting between the Gales and Chieftains, It will be the second ever meeting between the two schools.
- **2013 Meeting** Teays Valley dominated on both sides of the ball, limiting a Logan offense in transition to just 87 yards. The Vikings racked up 384 yards and 20 first half points. Logan's offense didn't manage a point until Nick Kost's TD run with 2:29 to play. Anthony Jones paced TV with 165 yards and a 58-yard touchdown.
- 2013 Round Up First year head coach Billy Burke brought a new attitude to Logan Chieftain Stadium, daring the Chieftains to "Restore Order" – declaring the intent to return discipline, expectations, and a winning attitude to the sideline. Despite an 1-3 start, Logan won 5 of their final six games on their way to securing the school's 26th SEOAL football championship.

Teays Valley fell flat after a 2-0 start, finishing 3-7 with only one win in the Mid-State League. The Vikings, however, lost four of their seven games by 10 points or less including two three point losses.

Aerial bombardment Logan unleashed a lethal passing attack on Lancaster last week, passing for 315 yards and five touchdowns in the Chiefs' 43-42 double-overtime loss. Junior Ouarterback Lane Little, playing his first full game for the purple and white, completed 24 of 40 passes for 306 yards and four touchdowns (he caught the team's fifth TD pass on a halfback pass from Dean Jordan).

Little's 40 attempts were a school record while the 306 passing yards were second only to Patrick Angle's 324 in a 2008 game. It was only the 4th 300+ yard passing game in school history. He also tied the school mark for single-game TD passes with four.

Chance Cox caught eight passes for 147 yards – 8th best all-time in terms of yardage and caught three touchdown passes - second only to his father Eric, who caught four against River Valley in 1994.

- Unsung hero.... Dean Jordan returned a Lancaster fumble 89-yards for a touchdown in the third quarter against Lancaster, giving Logan a 35-28 lead. It was longest fumble ever returned for a touchdown by a Chieftain. He also threw the game's opening touchdown pass to QB Lane Little on a halfback option.
- **SEOAL** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the SEOAL championship after a runner-up finish to Logan last season. The Ironmen return 21 of 24 starters after a 6-4 (3-1) finish in 2013. Logan was slotted as the runner-up, with Portsmouth third, Gallipolis fourth, and Warren fifth.
