- **Tonight's Match-up ....** The Logan Chieftains will celebrate Homecoming by welcoming the St. Francis DeSales Stallions at Logan Chieftain Stadium. The Stallions are the top Division III team in Ohio according to the Associated Press and enter with a 7-0 record. DeSales also leads the Division III, Region 11 Harbin Rankings that determine playoff seeding.

Logan lost their third straight game against Jackson last week 46-14, ending hopes at winning the final Southeastern Ohio Athletic League title. The Ironmen threw for 5 touchdowns in the victory.

DeSales trailed Edgewood 14-0 in the first quarter last week before rallying for a 48-21 victory. Running back Alonzo Booth is averaging nearly 200 yards and three touchdowns per game for the purple and white.

DeSales leads the all-time series with Logan 6-3.

- **Back again ....** This will be the first meeting between St. Francis DeSales and Logan played in Hocking County since the 2003 football season, a game won by DeSales 19-0. Since then, the Chieftains have moved from Bill Sauer Field on the Hilltop to Logan Chieftain Stadium.

This will not be the Stallions first game at "The Chief," however. DeSales played a regional championship football game against Athens here in 2014, a game in which Joey Burrow led the Bulldogs to a 52-20 victory.

- **So long, my friend ....** With their 46-14 victory over Logan last week, the Jackson Ironmen claimed the final Southeastern Ohio Athletic League football championship. The trophy is the 25<sup>th</sup> for the Ironmen. Logan won 26 titles in 92 league seasons. The SEOAL series between Jackson and Logan finished 42-42-2.

The SEOAL, the state's oldest continuously running non-city league in Ohio will come to an end at the end of the current academic year. After expanding to ten teams in 2006, the league quickly lost members beginning with Athens in 2008. Founding member Gallipolis left prior to the current school year for the Ohio Valley Conference and Jackson announced their intention to join an as-yet named league comprised largely of former members from the South Central Ohio League.

- **On this date ....** This will be the 16th game ever played by Logan on October 14. The Chieftains are 9-4-2 all-time on Oct 14 with 12 of the 15 prior games coming in SEOAL competition.

Strangely, a pair of 19-19 ties in 1949 (Jackson) and 1955 (Nelsonville) were played exactly six years apart on October 14. Logan last played on this date in 2011 here at Logan Chieftain Stadium in a 42-0 loss to Jonathan Alder.

- **Underclassman at Captain ....** Junior Dakota Dement was named the first full-time captain as an underclassman since Henry Adcock pulled the trick in 1924. Dement, who features on both the offensive and defensive lines, was chosen via a vote of his teammates alongside senior Colton Dixon and Kory Henthorne. The fourth captain spot will rotate each week.
