Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Logan makes its first ever trip to Cambridge tonight in the second ever meeting between the two schools. Logan won a thriller last season, defeating the Bobcats 47-31 at Logan Chieftain Stadium.

Cambridge, led by senior quarterback Nathan Snodgrass on offense and linebackers Garth Charlton and Koby Berger on defense, are 3-0 for the first time since 2011. CHS opened the season with victories over Indian Creek (26-19), John Glenn (17-13), and Canton South (13-6).

Logan was stopped on downs in the closing minutes after driving to the one yard line in a 25-19 loss to Meigs last week. The Logan offense scored its first points of the season early in the third quarter and rode the legs of running backs Jeremy Minor (110 yards) and Preston Yates (55 yards, TD) along with quarterback Brady Walsh (94 yards, TD) on offense while Minor collected 15 tackles on defense.

- **Polls and points** The Associated Press released their first high school football poll this week and Chieftain opponents were well represented. Cambridge opened the poll as the 13th ranked team in Division IV while Columbus St. Francis DeSales opened as the state's top team in Division III.

Cambridge currently sits fourth in the Division IV, Region 15 Harbin computer rankings that decide OHSAA playoff berths and seeding.

- **The waiting is the hardest part** It took ten scoreless quarters, but Logan finally broke through for their first score of 2016 when quarterback Brady Walsh juiced a Meigs linebacker and ran 21-yards on a read-option play to score the Chieftains first touchdown.

But six plays earlier, tailback Jeremy Minor had ripped off a nearly 50-yard scoring run that was called back due to penalty. Minor ended up gaining 110 yards on 10 carries in a break out game for the senior.

- **On this date** Logan is 5-5-1 in games played on September 16th. The date marked the season opener in 1938, '49, and '55 while it has been week four in 2005, 2011, and this season. Logan has played Lancaster (1949, '55), Hilliard (1966, '77), and Zanesville (1994, 2005) twice each on September 16th. Logan's last win came in 2005, a 23-20 thriller at Zanesville (won on a last minute field goal) and lost in 2011 to Jackson at home in the only SEOAL game played by Logan on September 16th.
- **Underclassman at Captain** Junior Dakota Dement was named the first full-time captain as an underclassman since Henry Adcock pulled the trick in 1924. Dement, who features on both the offensive and defensive lines, was chosen via a vote of his teammates alongside senior Colton Dixon and Kory Henthorne. The fourth captain spot will rotate each week.
- **SEOAL** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the final SEOAL football crown in near unanimous fashion. With only three SEOAL games remaining, the media panel chose the rebuilding Ironmen over a Logan team that must replace more than 80-percent of their offensive production and a Warren squad under a new head football coach.
