### **Game Notes:**

- Tonight's Match-up .... Tonight, the Logan Chieftains welcome the Hamilton Ross Rams for a senior night contest at Logan Chieftain Stadium. It will be the first ever meeting between Logan and RHS and only the second game ever against a Butler County foe in LHS history.

The Rams enter tonight's game 2-6 overall and 0-5 in the Southwest Ohio Conference. Like Logan, the rams have battle inexperience, injuries, and a very challenging schedule that features multiple teams bound for the OHSAA playoffs. Ross dropped a 42-7 decision to Little Miami last week.

Logan plays its final home game and enters 1-7 overall. The Chieftains lone win came over a 6-2 Athens teams still in the playoff hunt. Logan losses include likely playoff teams Dubin Jerome, Cambridge, Nelsonville-York, and St. Francis DeSales.

- Taking the long road .... The Rams will travel nearly 160 miles just to get to Logan Chieftain Stadium today. The Butler Countians will travel nearly 70 miles farther than Loudonville in 2013 which was the farthest trip a Chieftain opponent has made to Logan Chieftain Stadium.

For next year's return game, Logan will travel to Butler County for the second time. Logan went to Hamilton to play the HHS Big Blue in 1924.

On this date .... This will be the 11th game ever played by Logan on October 21. The Chieftains are 7-4 all-time on Oct 21 with all but one of the previous games coming against SEOAL competition. Most recently, Logan lost a double-overtime heartbreaker to Portsmouth in 2011 by a 24-21 score here at Logan Chieftain Stadium.

The Chieftain clinched a share of the league title winning 35-29 against Gallipolis on this day in 2005 in a wild game that ended with the Logan Police Department moving between the visitor's bleachers and the field of player after objects were thrown on the field after a late game injury to a Blue Devil player.

- Underclassman at Captain .... Junior Dakota Dement was named the first full-time captain as an underclassman since Henry Adcock pulled the trick in 1924. Dement, who features on both the offensive and defensive lines, was chosen via a vote of his teammates alongside senior Colton Dixon and Kory Henthorne. The fourth captain spot will rotate each week.
- **So long, my friend ....** With their 46-14 victory over Logan, the Jackson Ironmen claimed the final Southeastern Ohio Athletic League football championship. The trophy is the 25<sup>th</sup> for the Ironmen. Logan won 26 titles in 92 league seasons. The SEOAL series between Jackson and Logan finished 42-42-2.

The SEOAL, the state's oldest continuously running non-city league in Ohio will come to an end at the end of the current academic year. After expanding to ten teams in 2006, the league quickly lost members beginning with Athens in 2008. Founding member Gallipolis left prior to the current school year for the Ohio Valley Conference and Jackson announced their intention to join the newly named Frontier Athletic Conference.
