Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** The Jackson Ironmen and Logan Chieftains meet for the 94th, and at least for next few seasons, last time here at Alumni Stadium. Logan leads the all-time series 46-43-4, however, the Ironmen have beaten Logan each of the last two seasons and five of the last six years.

Logan won its first game of the season in dramatic last week by beating Athens 31-30 last week. The Bulldogs led 7-0, 17-10, and 24-10 before Logan answered with three unanswered touchdowns. Athens scored with: 32 remaining, but Kory Henthorne blocked the PAT to secure the victory for LHS, their 14th in a row over the Bulldogs.

Jackson moved to 4-2 with a dominating 63-14 victory over SEOAL foe Warren. The Ironmen capitalized on Warrior miscues and dominated the line of scrimmage

- **Coaching Milestones** Jackson head coach Andy Hall became the winningest Coach in JHS history when the Ironmen secured his 64th win last week against Warren. Hall surpassed Jackson legend Jim Reynolds. Reynolds coached from 1981-1984 and again from 1993-1997.

The Ironmen have made the playoffs four times in seven years under hall and also won four SEOAL titles.

Logan head coach Billy Burke won his 20th game as Chieftain Mentor last week in his fourth season. Dale Amyx (1990-2009) is the all-time wins leader at LHS with 140.

- **All square?** While the all-time series between the two schools is 46-43-4 in favor of Logan, eight of those match-ups came before the founding of the SEOAL. In only SEOAL games, Logan's lead is just one – 42-41-2. The Ironmen can even the all-time SEOAL series for eternity with a victory tonight. The Ironmen can't match the Chieftains 26 SEOAL football championships however, even if they clinch their 25th tonight.
- **Happy trails** Tonight marks the final SEOAL contest for Jackson, a founding member of the state's oldest, continuously running non-city league. The Ironmen will move to a new league next school year; the as-yet unnamed conference will include Chillicothe, Greenfield-McClain, Hillsboro, Miami Trace, and Washington Courthouse.
- **On this date** This will be the 15th game ever played by Logan on October 7. The Chieftains are 6-8 all-time on Oct 7. Logan and Jackson played on this date way back in 1921, a 34-0 Logan victory.

Memorably, Logan defeated Ironton on Oct. 7, 1977, 20-14, on their way to an undefeated season. Ironton took an early 6-0 lead before Dave Dalton blocked a field goal attempt which Alan McKinley returned 65-yards for a go-ahead touchdown. Ironton answered to take a 14-13 lead, leading to a winning two-yard scoring run by halfback John Kemper with just 1:12 to play.

- **Underclassman at Captain** Junior Dakota Dement was named the first full-time captain as an underclassman since Henry Adcock pulled the trick in 1924.
