Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight marks the 17th match-up between the Meigs Marauders and the Logan Chieftains, and the second at Farmers' Bank Stadium. Logan and Meigs played every season from 1967, when Meigs High School opened, until the school left the SEOAL following the 1982-83 school year. The two teams resumed their rivalry in 2014 when Logan defeated Meigs 55-7 here in Rock Springs.

Logan won last season in come from behind fashion when current Chieftain quarterback Brady Walsh turned a short slant route into a 47-yard score with 2:35 to play. The Chieftains are 0-2 with back to back shut-out losses.

The Marauders are 1-1 with a victory over rival and former SEOAL member Gallia Academy (42-7) and a loss against traditional power Amanda-Clearcreek (14-20).

- **Chieftains vs. Meigs County** When Meigs High School formed in 1967 (along with consolidated Nelsonville-York and a consolidated Athens), it ended a 30-year run of unchanged membership in the SEOAL. Prior to 1967, Logan faced off against both the Middleport Yellow Jackets and Pomeroy Purple Panthers nearly every season. From 1929-1966 Logan and Middleport played 36 times, with only 1934 as an exception. Logan and Pomeroy played 35 times starting in 1928 (Logan did not play PHS in '29, '36, and '37).

Logan was 24-11-1 against the Yellow Jackets and 21-10-4 against the Panthers. While Pomeroy only won one SEOAL championship, Middleport won nine championships which was second all-time to Jackson when the school closed.

- **Underclassman at Captain** Junior Dakota Dement was named the first full-time captain as an underclassman since Henry Adcock pulled the trick in 1924. Dement, who features on both the offensive and defensive lines, was chosen via a vote of his teammates alongside senior Colton Dixon and Kory Henthorne. The fourth captain spot will rotate each week.
- **On this date** Logan is 3-9 all-time in games played on September 9th since 1960. Prior to 1960 the season opened later in the fall, and the season opened on this date in 1960, '66, and 1977. That 1977 opener came against New Lexington, a game Logan won 30-6 on their way to a perfect 10-0 season. It was Logan's first victory against New Lexington after five straight losses under New Lex coach Jim Rockwell.
- **SEOAL** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the final SEOAL football crown in near unanimous fashion. With only three SEOAL games remaining, the media panel chose the rebuilding Ironmen over a Logan team that must replace more than 80-percent of their offensive production and a Warren squad under a new head football coach.
