Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight the Chieftains and Vikings will meet for the fourth time in what has been a competitive series led by TVHS 2-1. The two teams combined for 84 points here in Ashville two years ago, while Logan recorded their first win in the series last year (27-7).

Logan is looking to rebound from a 58-0 thrashing at the hands of Dublin Jerome last week while the Vikings defeated Westfall 31-23 in the final game between those two schools. Under current head coach Mark Weber, TVHS has finished 8-3 the last two seasons including back-to-back MSL titles and DII playoff appearances.

- **Youth movement** Logan returns only nine letterwinners from last season and last week's starting line-up against Dublin Jerome featured a freshman in the season opener for the first time since 1912. Freshman Conner Ruff was joined by a pair of sophomores. On offense, a pair of sophomores paired together in at the two running back positions.
- **Underclassman at Captain** Junior Dakota Dement was named the first full-time captain as an underclassman since Henry Adcock pulled the trick in 1924. Dement, who features on both the offensive and defensive lines, was chosen via a vote of his teammates alongside senior Colton Dixon and Kory Henthorne. The fourth captain spot will rotate each week.
- **The kind of records** You don't want to set. In last week's 58-0 defeat at the hands of Dublin Jerome, the Chieftain suffered their worst loss via shut-out and their largest margin of defeat ever, besting Columbus West's 62-7 win at Logan in 1930. At least the Celtics didn't top 62 points, still the most allowed by an LHS team.
- **Pre-season All-America** Paul Wesselhoeft, a red-shirt senior at Ohio Dominican University, was tabbed as a second team All-American by D2Football.com. The 6-5, 285-pound defensive lineman was a First Team All-GLIAC selection last fall.

Isaiah Smith, who starred last fall for the purple and white at receiver and defensive back, is a freshman at ODU this fall.

- **SEOAL** A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Jackson as the favorite to win the final SEOAL football crown in near unanimous fashion. With only three SEOAL games remaining, the media panel chose the rebuilding Ironmen over a Logan team that must replace more than 80-percent of their offensive production and a Warren squad under a new head football coach.
