### **Notes**:

- Tonight's Match-up .... Tonight's Homecoming match-up is the first ever meeting between Logan and Dublin Scioto and Logan's second match-up against the Dublin City School District in 2017, following their 41-7 week one loss to Dublin Jerome. The Chieftains also hosted Dublin Coffman in a 2001 DI playoff game at Bill Sauer Field, completing their DSCS bingo card.

Scioto opened the season 0-2, dealing with multiple injuries in losses to Westerville South (14-50) and Dublin Coffman (0-38); the Irish responded with wins over Big Walnut (51-21) and Delaware-Hayes (10-0) sandwiching a close loss to Dublin Jerome (17-21). Scioto defeated archrival Worthington Kilbourne 34-21 last week in a game that wasn't as close as the final score appears.

Logan snapped a three game losing streak with an exciting 48-42 double overtime victory over Minford last week. Logan trailed 35-7 deep into the third quarter before scoring 35 unanswered points. It was the largest come back in school history.

- **Dublin Double** .... As previously mentioned, tonight caps off Logan's "Dublin Double." The Chieftains fell to Jerome in the season opener (41-7) and hosts Scioto tonight for Homecoming. Logan also hosted Dublin Coffman in a DI playoff game back in 2001, a 20-14 loss. All-time Logan sits 1-3 against Dublin high schools having defeated Jerome 23-7 for their lone victory in a 2008 DII playoff game here at Logan Chieftain Stadium.
- **Truly epic comeback ....** Last week's come from behind 48-42 double overtime victory over Minford also marked Logan's largest come from behind victory ever. Logan trailed 35-7 with just :50 to play in the third quarter. The 28 point margin shattered the previous best comeback, a 19 point turn around against Marietta in 2003. Logan has won games where it trailed by double digits fourteen times in school history. Here is a brief list of the two touchdown comebacks:
  - 28 points, 2017, trailed Minford 35-7, won 48-42 (2OT)
  - 19 points, 2003, trailed Marietta 19-0, won 40-19
  - 16 points, 2005, trailed Chillicothe 16-0, won 29-23
  - 14 points, 1998, trailed Nelsonville-York 14-0, won 34-29
  - 14 points, 2016, trailed Athens 24-10, won 31-30
  - 13 points, 1939, trailed Middleport 20-7, won 21-20
  - 13 points, 1954, trailed Pomeroy 0-13, won 14-13
  - 13 points, 2015, trailed Meigs 0-13, won 27-22
  - 12 points, 1951, trailed Athens 0-12, won 13-12
  - 12 points, 1993, trailed Nelsonville-York 0-12, won 35-18
- On this (spooky) date .... Tonight is appropriately Logan's 13<sup>th</sup> game ever played on October 13. All but one of those games has been played on a Friday. The Chieftains are 9-3 on October 13, with their first victory coming in a 26-0 victory at Nelsonville in 1917 and their last win coming at Warren (65-0) in 2006. This will be the first October 13 game played at Logan Chieftain Stadium, after which Logan will have used three different home field on the date including the Hocking County Fairgrounds (1922) and Bill Sauer Field (1933-2006). Logan's three losses came in tight contests against Nelsonville (6-7 in 1922), Ironton (0-7 in 1972), and Gallipolis (24-30 in 1995).

- Overdue for overtime win .... With last week's 48-42 double overtime victory, the Chieftains snapped a four game losing streak in games that have gone to overtime. The Chiefs last won an overtime game way back in 1999 when they defeated Zanesville 20-14 at Bill Sauer Field. At that point, the Chieftains were 4-1 in overtime games. Between 2011 and 2014 Logan went 0-4 in extra sessions, including three losses in double overtime. The victory over Minford was the first win in a multi-overtime game. - **Billy's back** .... Head coach Billy Burke is back for his fifth season in charge of the purple and white. Only four (of 32) LHS coaches' have coached more than five seasons at the school. Burke is 23-20 so far at LHS and won Logan's 26<sup>th</sup> Southeastern Ohio Athletic League championship in his first season (2013). Burke's staff includes five former Chieftains.
- **Youth movement ....** After seeing only four freshmen earn varsity letters in *fifty years*, the purple and white saw four freshmen earn letters in 2016 alone. Three of those letter winners are back in addition to six juniors who were starters as sophomores last season. Rounding out the youth movement, Dakota Dement was the first underclassman to serve as captain since 1920. Logan hopes that last year's growing pains become this season's success stories.
- Noteworthy captains .... Speaking of captains, a trio of seniors Dakota Dement, Carter Hodson, and Brady Walsh have been named full time captains for the 2017 season. Dement is the first multi-year captain since Anthony Schrader was captain in 1920-1921 and just the third all-time. Walsh, a quarterback and safety, is the son of LHS assistant coach Pat Walsh.
- Into the wilderness .... Logan High School is without an athletic league or conference for the first time since the 1924-25 school year. The Southeastern Ohio Athletic League which once was home to schools such as Athens, Gallipolis, Ironton, Jackson, Marietta, and Portsmouth indefinitely suspended operations in the spring. Prior to that, the league had been the longest continually operation non-city league in the state of Ohio. Logan was one of only two founding members to compete in every school year of the league's existence.
