Game Notes:

- Tonight's Match-up Tonight marks the fifth meeting between Logan and Teays Valley, a series that started in 2013. The Vikings own a 3-1 record against the Chieftains, winning 21-0 last fall in Ashville.

For the first time, both teams enter the contest winless. Logan was trounced by Dublin Jerome last Friday (41-7) while the Vikings fell in heartbreaking fashion against Chillicothe (31-27). TV had leads of 14-0, 21-14, and 27-21 before seeing a last minute pass intercepted in the end zone.

- Hardwood (and Hall of Fame) Heroes The Logan High School Athletic Hall of Fame will officially induct its 2017 class during a pre-game ceremony. All three inductees – Patrick Angle ('09), Abbey Jennings ('00), and Katie McBroom ('00) have one thing in common. They are among only 15 players (10 girls, 5 boys) to score 1,000 points in their basketball careers.

Angle was a standout in football where he set nearly every LHS passing mark, basketball, and baseball; **Jennings** in tennis, basketball, and softball; and **McBroom** in volleyball, basketball, and softball.

Angle was only the second LHS athlete to receive a statewide player of the year award (following Katie Smith) when he was name the AP's Division II offensive player of the year in 2009. Jennings and McBroom teamed up for a 20-2 season their senior year in basketball and also teamed up for an SEOAL softball championship.

- **Youth movement** After seeing only four freshmen earn varsity letters in *fifty years*, the purple and white saw four freshmen earn letters in 2016 alone. Three of those letter winners are back in addition to six juniors who were starters as sophomores last season. Rounding out the youth movement, Dakota Dement was the first underclassman to serve as captain since 1920. Logan hopes that last year's growing pains become this season's success stories.
- Noteworthy captains Speaking of captains, a trio of seniors Dakota Dement, Carter Hodson, and Brady Walsh have been named full time captains for the 2017 season.
 Dement is the first multi-year captain since Anthony Schrader was captain in 1920-1921 and just the third all-time. Walsh, a quarterback and safety, is the son of LHS assistant coach Pat Walsh.
- Into the wilderness Logan High School is without an athletic league or conference for the first time since the 1924-25 school year. The Southeastern Ohio Athletic League which once was home to schools such as Athens, Gallipolis, Ironton, Jackson, Marietta, and Portsmouth indefinitely suspended operations in the spring. Prior to that, the league had been the longest continually operation non-city league in the state of Ohio. Logan was one of only two founding members to compete in every school year of the league's existence.
- On this date Tonight marks the sixth Chieftain football game played on September 1 and the first since 2006, a 31-21 loss to Chillicothe. Logan is 2-2-1 on this date including the programs first ever overtime game, a 6-0 victory over Nelsonville-York in 1989. Logan's last victory on September 1st came in a 28-3 victory at Nelsonville-York in 2000.
