## **Game Notes:**

- Tonight's Match-up .... Tonight marks the second ever regular season meeting between Logan and Sheridan, although the two teams did meet up for their final preseason tune-up for over 15 years. Sheridan won last year's meeting 44-7.

The Generals enter with a 3-0 (2-0) record, defeating Licking Valley (36-21), Maysville (49-0), and John Glenn (37-7). Sheridan went 6-4 last season, but led in the second half of all four losses. The Generals' high expectations include dethroning reigning Muskingum Valley League champion Tri-Valley and qualifying for the DIII, Region 11 playoffs.

Logan got their first victory of the season last week, defeating Meigs 45-35 in comeback fashion. A large group of Chieftains played their part – including quarterback Braeden Spatar, receiver Landon Little (who caught a pair of touchdowns), and running back Preston Yates (who scored the go ahead TD and returned an interception for touchdown on the game's final play).

- State rankings .... The strength of Logan's 2018 schedule was highlighted in the inaugural Associate Press statewide rankings released this week. Tonight's opponent, Sheridan, came in as the 20<sup>th</sup> team in Division III. Future opponents Chillicothe (18) and Garfield Heights (20) appeared in the Division II poll. Waverly, who Logan will face in week ten, is 12<sup>th</sup> in the Division IV poll. Surprisingly, Tri-Valley (3-0) Logan's week one opponent and the 2017 DIII runner-up, did not appear in the DII poll.
- Wait who's that? .... OL/DL Nick Anderson, who missed the first two weeks of the season due to suspension, has switched jersey numbers from 82 to 73 with senior Steven Lewis. Anderson returned a short kickoff last week, but it was mistakenly (and temporarily) credited to Lewis. Senior captain Clay Risch wore number 61 instead of his usual 56 against the Marauders.
- Who to watch: Logan .... As previously mentioned, Logan's offense hopes it found an identity last week behind Spatar, Yates, and Little. Spatar, a dual threat QB, completed 11 of 17 passes for 154 yards and three scores the first three TD game by a Logan quarterback since 2016. Little's pair of touchdown grabs punctuated his best performance of the season (5 rec, 90 yards). Yates, who last year joined his dad Chris in the 1,000+ yard club (the only father/son duo ever to do that at LHS), scored his first touchdown of the season.
- Who to watch: Sheridan .... For the Generals, quarterback Ethan Heller is best known for his basketball ability, but the senior southpaw leads the team with 147 yards rushing and has completed 35 of 50 passes for 678 yards and seven touchdowns. He set the school single passing mark by throwing for 310 yards against Licking Valley. He is a deep threat throwing four TD passes of 45+ yards.

Jacob Rhodes, a receiver/defensive back, is a speedster who set school and MVL records in the 100m (10.80) last spring as he finished second at the OHSAA track meet. Rhodes has caught 13 passes for 267 yards, including three touchdowns. Logan Ranft (sophomore) is averaging an eye catching 40.3 yards per catch.

- On this date .... This will be the eleventh Chieftain football game played on September 14. The purple and white are 6-4- on this date. Logan opened the 1945, '51, and '56 seasons on Sept. 14.
