## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight marks the sixth meeting between Teays Valley and Logan, with the Chieftains' lone win coming in 2015 by a 27-7 score. The Vikings, under fifth year head coach Mark Weber, have become a dominant force in the Mid-State League Buckeye Division. The blue and gold have won at least a share of the division three out of four seasons under Weber and have twice qualified for the Division II playoffs.

The Vikings enter with an 0-1 record following a heartbreaking 14-13 loss at Chillicothe last Friday. Teays Valley took a 13-2 lead early in the fourth quarter of a defensive slug fest – but Chillicothe returned the ensuing kickoff to cut the lead to 13-8 and score the winning touchdown with less than a minute to play. Tonight marks the home opener for the Pickaway Countians.

Logan took a 48-7 shellacking from Tri-Valley, the defending Muskingum Valley League champions and 2017 Division III state runners-up. The Scotties benefitted from a pair of touchdown returns (interception, kickoff) that bookended an outstanding display from TV receiver Blayze Taylor who was on the receiving end up three touchdowns passes.

- **Future league rivals? ....** According to multiple reports last school year, Teays Valley and Logan were near an agreement to form a new league based around the US 33 corridor. Teays Valley, Canal Winchester, Groveport-Madison, Lancaster, Newark, Zanesville, and Logan were amongst a wider group of teams interested in forming a new conference of Division I and II schools. The bulk of those schools currently compete in the Ohio Capital Conference which decided to realign their divisions to appease many of those schools in 2020.
- **Good opening week for opponents ....** Logans' 2018 opponents had a strong opening week. As mentioned earlier, Chillicothe topped Teays Valley 14-13 in the only game featuring two future Chieftain opponents. In the other 8 games, Logan's opponents went 5-2 with wins from Sheridan (36-21 over Licking Valley), Athens (51-26 over Warren), Zanesville (32-27 over Newark), Garfield Heights (42-0 over Lakewood), and Waverly (50-6 over Piketon). The lone losses were by Meigs (34-47 against Gallipolis) and Bishop Watterson (14-41 against Dublin Jerome).
- **Into the wilderness ....** Logan High School remains without an athletic league or conference for the first time since the 1924-25 school year. The Southeastern Ohio Athletic League – which once was home to schools such as Athens, Gallipolis, Ironton, Jackson, Marietta, and Portsmouth - indefinitely suspended operations in the spring. Prior to that, the league had been the longest continually operation non-city league in the state of Ohio. Logan was one of only two founding members to compete in every school year of the league's existence.
- **On this date ....** This will be the sixth Chieftain football game played on August 31<sup>st</sup> and just the second played away from home. The Chieftains opened both the 1979 (6-14 loss, away) and 1984 (26-14 win) seasons on August 31 against the New Lexington Panthers.

Logan has split four week two match-ups on this date, defeating Nelsonville-York (50-6) and Chillicothe (47-18) in 2001 and 2007 respectively, while dropping games to Chillicothe (6-17) and Northland (26-32, overtime) in 1990 and 2012 respectively.
