Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** The Logan Chieftains travel to Chillicothe for a rare Thursday night contest which will be broadcast on the CW Columbus as part of their Thursday Night Lights series. It will be Logan's first Thursday night Varsity football game since 1955. The two teams have a single common opponent, Teays Valley, who topped CHS 14-0 in week one and the Chieftains 10-7 in week two.

It will be the 17th match-up between the two schools who first met in 1990. The Cavs lead the series 9-7 and have won the last two meetings. Last year's matchup ended when CHS stopped Logan on a two-point try in overtime, giving the blue and white a 7-6 victory. The game was the first scoreless (regulation) game since Logan defeated Nelsonville-York 6-0 (OT) in 1989.

Chillicothe is 1-3 on the season, defeating Columbus Mifflin 27-14 in week two. Losses came against Teays Valley (14-0), Watkins Memorial (26-14), and to Columbus Centennial last week by a 48-15 score. CHS led 8-0, and closed to within 28-15 at halftime before the Stars pulled away in the second half.

Logan lost a heartbreaker to Sheridan last week in losing to the Generals 14-7 and are riding the longest losing streak in school history, 11 games. Logan scored within the game's first minute to take a 7-0 lead into the locker room but had a special teams miscue and a lost fumble to give the Generals the opportunity to score twice inside of 4 minutes to start the second half. Logan previously lost to Tri-Valley (35-7), Teays Valley (10-7), and Jackson (28-7).

- **Millennial game** Last week marked Logan's 1,000th Varsity football game in program history. The Chieftains all-time record is 568-395-37 since Varsity play began in 1912.

- **Thursday Night Lights** Tonight is Logan's 27th Thursday game in program history. Fourteen of the previous 26 games were played on Thanksgiving Day, with Logan going 10-1-1 against Nelsonville and 0-1 against Gallipolis on the holiday. During the 1930s and 1940s several games were moved to Thursday night due to teaching conferences held at Ohio University on Fridays.

Overall Logan is 16-7-3 on Thursdays, but did lose the last two Thursday night games against Gallipolis (31-7 in 1954) and Wellston (27-20 in 1955). Logan's last Thursday night victory was back in 1945, a 21-0 victory over New Lexington.

- **Who to watch: Logan** The Chieftains average 206 yards per game on offense, with 138 of that total coming via the ground game. Logan had their most successful passing game of the season with quarterback *Braeden Spatar* connecting on 11 of 15 passes for 139 yards while receiver *Garrett Mace* caught seven passes for 99 yards. Spatar also led the Chieftain in rushing with 84 yards on 23 carries. Junior running back *Caden McCarty* continues to be a workhorse for the purple and white, carrying 68 times for 280 yards and three touchdowns.

Defensively, the purple and white are allowing 264.5 total yards per game with 140 of that total coming on the ground. Cornerback *Colten Castle* recorded his first career interception while recording six total tackles last week. DT *Josh Chapin* recorded a team nine tackles, including three for a loss while end *Henry Pierce* recorded seven total tackles including two for loss and a sack despite being in and out of the lineup due to injury.

- **Who to watch: Chillicothe** On offense Chillicothe is averaging 208 yards per game almost evenly split between the ground and aerial assaults. Quarterback *Christian Benson* has completed 35 of 66 passes for 358 yards, but has only one TD pass compared to six interceptions. Running back *Hunter Thompson* scored his first TD last week and has run for 313 yards on 71 carries. *Logan Snowden* is the top receiver with nine catches for 140 yards and a touchdown.

Defensively the Cavaliers are allowing just over 309 yards per game including nearly 176 per game on the ground. Linebacker *Courtland Duncan* is a physical presence while *Patrick Rourke* is an anchor on the front line. Cornerback *Tyce Netter* and safety *Joel Barnes* lead the secondary.

- **New sheriff in town** Mike Eddy was named Logan's 31st head football coach in January. The new Chieftain boss had a 52-52 career record at Gallipolis and Parkersburg South (WV) High Schools. A graduate of Tyler County (WV) High School and Fairmont State University, Eddy was an assistant at powerhouse Parkersburg (WV) High School from 2004-2008. His 2012 Gallia Academy team won an SEOAL championship and advanced to the second round of the OHSAA DIII playoffs. He left Gallipolis with a 24-18 overall record.
- **Veteran and local coaching staff** Coach Eddy retained the majority of the existing coaching staff, while also welcoming back former Chieftain head coach and long-time assistant coach Kelly Wolfe. Wolfe, who was head coach from 2010-2012, had previously been an assistant from 1990-2009.

Eddy's staff includes five former Chieftains who all were captains during their playing days. Eddy and assistant Jim Huntsberger are the lone non-LHS graduates, but Huntsberger has been on Logan's coaching staff since 1990.

- **On this date** Logan has played 13 games on September 26, winning nine and losing four. Notably, Logan defeated Middleport 20-12 in 1941, Athens 39-7 in 1952, Pomeroy 14-6 in 1958, and Zanesville 16-14 in 2008 on their way to Southeastern Ohio Athletic League championships. In the loss column, Columbus West defeated Logan 62-7 in 1930 which is still a school record for points allowed and fell 9-7 to Columbus St. Francis DeSales in 1987, the only loss for the school's first ever playoff qualifier.
