Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** The Logan Chieftains host the Sheridan Generals at Logan Chieftain Stadium. It will mark just the third meeting all-time between the two schools and the 1,000th Varsity football game for LHS. The Generals lead the series 2-0, beating the Chieftains 44-7 in 2017 and 42-7 in 2018.

Sheridan is 2-1 on the season, including an exciting come from behind 13-12 victory over John Glenn last week. Luken Hill caught the game winning TD pass with :20 left, the second of his two scoring receptions. The Generals lost their opener to Licking Valley 21-7 and shut-out Maysville (21-0) in their other victory.

Logan fell to 0-3 with a 28-7 loss at ancient rival Jackson last week. The game was deadlocked (7-7) at halftime, but a stifling Ironman defense and a punishing ground game turned the tide in the second half. The Jackson defensive line helped force a pair of interceptions that led to touchdowns. Logan lost their opener to Tri-Valley (35-7) and a heartbreaker to Teays Valley (10-7) in their home debut.

- **Millennial game (by the numbers)** Logan HS played its first official Varsity football game on Oct. 5, 1912. The Chieftains defeated Murray City by a 46-0 score at Wright Field (located on Hunter St.).

Wright Field was the first of **(4)** home fields used by the Chieftains who also called the Hocking County Fairgrounds, Bill Sauer Field, and now Logan Chieftain Stadium home.

Logan has had **(7)** perfect undefeated/untied regular seasons – 1934, 1964, 1977, 2000, 2001, 2008, and 2009 – and never had a winless (full) season. The Chieftains have made **(8)** OHSAA playoff appearances.

The current **(10)** game losing streak is the longest in history. Logan won a school record **(18)** straight games from 1963-'65, they have won **(26)** league titles, and won **(29)** straight regular season games from 1999-'01 and again from 2007-'09. **(31)** men have served as head football coach.

The purple and white have had **(43)** players named to the All-Ohio 1st, 2nd, or 3rd teams. The largest losing margin in school history came in a **(59)**-0 loss to Athens in 1919, they allowed a school record **(62)** points against Columbus West in 1930, and trounced New Lexington **(81)**-0 for the biggest winning margin and points scored record in 1920.

This is the **(108th)** varsity football season at Logan High School. The Chieftains have an all-time record of **(568)**-394-37

- **Who to watch: Logan** On offense, Logan has been as successful as backfield duo *Braeden Spatar (QB)* and *Caden McCarty (RB)* have been. Spatar connected on his first TD pass of the season last week. The LHS offense hopes to find better diversity and to involve their perimeter plays more this week against Sheridan.

Defensively, junior *Quinn Walsh* has earned the second starting spot at inside linebacker after making ten stops last week against Jackson. Hybrid linebacker/defensive back *Jonny McClelland* made his second interception of the season while *Traten Poling* made his first defensive start, recording nine tackles. Cornerback *Colten Castle* recorded a career high 11 tackles.

- **Who to watch: Sheridan** On offense quarterback *Nate Johnson* has thrown for 303 yards and three touchdowns and is second on the team with 249 rushing yards and leads the team with two rushing touchdowns. *Will Hamilton* is the top runner, gaining 267 yards on 43 carries while *Luken Hill* and *Logan Ranft* are the top pass catchers.

Defensively the Generals are stingy between the tackles thanks to downhill linebacker play from *Shay Taylor* and *Jared Elson*. *Alec Ogle* is one of the rare veterans on the Sheridan defense who graduated all 11 starters from last year's regional finalist.

- **New sheriff in town** Mike Eddy was named Logan's 31st head football coach in January. The new Chieftain boss had a 52-52 career record at Gallipolis and Parkersburg South (WV) High Schools. A graduate of Tyler County (WV) High School and Fairmont State University, Eddy was an assistant at powerhouse Parkersburg (WV) High School from 2004-2008. His 2012 Gallia Academy team won an SEOAL championship and advanced to the second round of the OHSAA DIII playoffs. He left Gallipolis with a 24-18 overall record.
- **Welcome back** One of the first moves Eddy made after accepting the LHS head coaching job was to put together the rest of his coaching staff. An early call was made to Kelly Wolfe, former legendary player and head coach at LHS. Wolfe is back on the Chieftain sideline following a six-year hiatus and will be the offensive coordinator, quarterbacks coach, and offensive play caller. Wolfe previously coached in some capacity from 1991-2012.

Eddy's staff includes five former Chieftains who all were captains during their playing days. Eddy and assistant Jim Huntsberger are the lone non-LHS graduates, but Huntsberger has been on Logan's coaching staff since 1990.

- **On this date** Logan has played 14 games on September 20, winning five and losing nine, including their last four on this date. Twelve of the games have been played at home while the school's 500th game was played on this date in 1968.
