Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight's game will open the 2019 season and represent just the third all-time meeting between Logan and Tri-Valley. The Scotties lead the series 2-0, defeating Logan in a first round playoff game in 2007 and in last season's opener. This is the first game between the two schools played at Tri-Valley.

While the **Scotties** were rebuilding under first year coach and Ohio HS Football Coaches Association Hall of Famer Kevin Fell last fall, they still managed to share the Muskingum Valley League title for the eighth straight season while also advancing to the second round of the DII playoffs.

Playing the statistically most difficult schedule in school history – a schedule that saw nine teams finish .500 or better, five qualify for the OHSAA playoffs, and five win league titles – **Logan** limped to a 1-9 overall record.

- **Who to watch: Logan** On offense, Logan's new read based system will rely on the decision-making of quarterback Braeden Spatar. The senior was second on the team in rushing yards last season with 531 while passing for 644 while completing 53-percent of his passes (55-104). Joining him in the backfield is junior Caden McCarty who missed nearly all of last season with a knee injury. Coaches expected McCarty to earn playing time complimenting Preston Yates at tailback last fall.

Defensively Logan welcomes back linebacker Colton Ruff, who along with twin brother Conner, seem poised to become just the 7th and 8th 4-year letterwinners in program history. Only Bryce McBride (2012-'15) has done it since 1963. While Conner starts the season recovering from a knee injury, Colton will anchor the Chieftain defense at inside linebacker. The secondary, featuring Colten Castle, Garrett Mace, and junior Jonny McClelland (in a hybrid role) is another strength.

- **Who to watch: Tri-Valley** The Tri-Valley Scotties expect to reload after a 10-2 season that saw an eighth straight MVL title and a first round road playoff win behind an experienced junior backfield. Quarterback Aidan Fritter threw for 625 yards while complete 65-percent of his passes (52-81) last season while running backs Jordan Pantaleo (701 yards, 9 TDs, 141 carries) and Blake Sands (339 yards, 4TDs, 79 carries) also return.
- **Eddy debut** Tonight marks the debut for Logan's 31st head football coach, Mike Eddy. A native of Tyler County, WV, he previously was head coach at Parkersburg South and Gallia Academy and prior to that an assistant at Parkersburg High School. Eddy's career record is 52-52, including four playoff appearances.

Logan grid bosses have a 12-14-1 record in coaching debuts since formal records began in 1912. Logan's last three head coaches – Billy Burke, Kelly Wolfe, and Dale Amyx all lost in their debuts. Clarence Perry was the last Chieftain mentor to win his debut, defeating New Lexington 26-8 in 1985.

- **Welcome back** One of the first moves Eddy made after accepting the LHS head coaching job was to put together the rest of his coaching staff. An early call was made to Kelly Wolfe, former legendary player and head coach at LHS. Wolfe is back on the Chieftain sideline following a six-year hiatus and will be the offensive coordinator, quarterbacks coach, and offensive play caller. Wolfe previously coached in some capacity from 1991-2012.
- **Millennial game on the way** Logan will play its 1,000th football game since becoming a Varsity sport in 1912 this season. Currently, Logan has played 995 total games winning 568, losing 390, and tying 37 for a .589 win percentage. Logan's 1,000th game is scheduled for Thursday, September 26 at Chillicothe.
- **MVL opener tradition** Logan has played a team currently representing the MVL to open the season a remarkable 33 times. 29 of those games came against New Lexington who marked Logan's season opener 26 times between 1974 and 2002. Logan also opened the season against Crooksville in 1927 and 1928 (which predates the creation of the MVL) and opened with Tri-Valley last season.
- **On this date** Logan has four wins against a single loss in games played on August 30. Four of the five previous games were season openers, while the game in 2002 was the second week of the season. Two other head coaching debuts occurred on Aug. 30 with Clarence Perry's team beating New Lexington 26-8 in 1985 while Billy Burke lost his debut to Lancaster 57-7 in 2013.
