Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the first ever Varsity football contest between Bloom-Carroll and Logan. B-C is one of three Mid-State League Ohio opponents that appear as first-time opponents on the Chieftains replacement 2020 schedule joining Amanda-Clearcreek and Logan Elm. B-C are ranked second in the initial statewide Division IV football poll and have made the playoffs each of the last four seasons.
- **Who to watch: Logan** Logan is struggling to establish a consistent running game so far in 2020, but the aerial attack piloted by senior quarterback *Ian Frasure* has found success. Frasure completed 16 of 28 passes for 236 yards and two scores last week, finding junior *Traten Poling* 6 times for 122 yards and both scores.

Defensively safety *Caden McCarty* had an outstanding game last week recording 15 tackles and causing a fumble with an excellent helmet-on-ball collision. *Henry Pierce* has been a consistent force from his defensive end position.

- **Who to watch: Bloom-Carroll** The Bulldog offense is averaging over six yards per rush attempt behind *Hobie Scarberry's* 261 yards and 2 scores on 37 carries. The Bulldogs run downhill using an option attack out of a variety of formations. Quarterback *KJ Benedict* is completing 75-percent of his passes (21-28) for 302 yards and four touchdowns without an interception.

But defense is the purple and gold calling card. They are allowing only 203 yards per game out of a base 3-4 defense and have only allowed a single touchdown in three games. *Joe Hatem* leads a physical defensive line with *Beau Wisecarver* providing a physical presence at safety.

- **On this date** This will be the thirteenth Chieftain football game ever played on September 18, with Logan holding an 8-3-1 record. The Chieftains recorded wins over Maysville (34-6) and Gallipolis (57-6) on their way to 10-0 seasons in 1964 and 2009 respectively. Perhaps the most memorable game on this date was a 20-19 victory over Columbus St. Francis DeSales on the old LHS hilltop field in 1992.
