Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the fourth ever meeting between Logan and Maysville with Logan holding a 3-0 in the all-time series. The two teams played a thriller last season with Logan prevailing 14-12 at the Maysville Athletic Complex. The previous meetings came in 1964 and 1973.

Logan finally broke into the win column last week, snapping a eight-game losing streak dating back to the 2019 season. The Chieftains topped Columbus East 50-6 despite not attempting a single pass.

Maysville is from the Muskingum Valley League which split into two divisions this fall for the first time. The Panthers opened with a non-league victory over Crooksville (20-0) before losing four straight. They upset Philo (43-42, OT) in week 6, but lost to the Electrics in a playoff rematch 43-0. The Panthers topped Morgan 42-21 in a non-league game last week.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Senior running back *Caden McCarty* ran for 174 yards and four touchdowns on 16 carries as Logan scored 50 points without throwing a single pass. Quarterback *Ian Frasure* added 21 yards and a score with junior *Traten Poling* having a big night gaining 90 yards and scoring twice on five attempts.

Sophomore defensive back *Brayden Sturgell* recorded nine tackles and recovered a fumble while freshman linebacker *Jack Brown* made 7 stops including one for loss in his first significant Varsity action. Senior end *Henry Pierce* recorded two sacks and made four total tackles.

- **Who to watch: Maysville** *Kaiden Hall* is the main offensive threat for the Panthers running for 648 yards and 11 touchdowns on 120 attempts while passing for 606 yards and two scores on 67 of 122 passing. Tight end *Logan Smith* is not only 6-foot-6, but leads the team in receiving yards with 191 and two scores on 14 receptions.

Defensively sophomore *Hayden Jarrett* is the team's top tackler from his linebacker post while *Nate Harper* and *Caden Searls* stand out in their hybrid roles. *Hall* is effective from his safety spot.

- **On this date** This will be the seventeenth Chieftain football game ever played on October 23rd, with Logan holding a 10-5-1 record. Their first game on this date was a 59-0 win over Murray City in 1914 and they won games in 1964 and 2009 on their way to perfect regular seasons.
