Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight's game will open the 2020 season – a statement many doubted would be possible a few months ago. While a global pandemic has changed the way we live, Logan football will play its 109th season this fall. A team representing Logan HS has played every fall since 1898. Ironically, during the 1918 influenza pandemic, Jackson and Logan played in a shortened season. It was just the second meeting between the two schools and finished scoreless.

Jackson is coming off an 11-1 season; the seventh perfect regular season in school history and third for Head Coach Andy Hall. Jackson has made the playoff seven times in eleven seasons under Hall.

Logan won four of their final six games to finish 4-6 overall. Three of Logan's six losses came by a single touchdown or less. The Chieftains put up their best defensive numbers in a decade and used a ball control offense to wear down opponents.

- **Watch from home** LHS TV-2 has covered Logan Chieftain football since the early 1980s. But tonight, for the first time, the school's media production team will broadcast a live Chieftain football game. With the decreased capacity due to COVID-19 restrictions, fans can watch from home by visiting **www. Plicktv.com** and purchasing a virtual ticket to watch a live stream for \$10.

And as always, the radio home for the Chieftains is 98.3 SAM FM. 98.3 has covered the Chieftains home and away since 1968. An online stream of the SAM FM broadcast can be found by visiting 98.3samfm.com.

- **Who to watch: Logan** On offense, Logan will undoubtedly rely on the legs of senior running back *Caden McCarty* who ran for 755 yards and 12 touchdowns on 163 carries last season. *Ian Frasure* takes over the quarterback job. Up front, tackle *Keiton Arledge* will anchor the offensive line.

Defensively Logan must replace a majority of their starters from last season, but return the teams top two tacklers in defensive back *Jonny McClelland* and end *Henry Pierce*. McClelland tied for the team lead in interceptions with three while Pierce tied for the team lead in tackles for loss with eight.

- **Who to watch: Jackson** For Jackson, West Virginia University commit *Treylan Davis* will be a key man at both tight end and on the defensive line. Davis is disruptive and athletic. *Jacob Winters* may be a sophomore but he may be next in the Ironman collegiate pipeline. The quarterback and safety will be a key contributor on both sides of the ball.

- **Captains** Logan named six captains this fall; Ian Frasure, Caden McCarty, Jonny McClelland, Henry Pierce, Traten Poling, and Quinn Walsh. McClelland is just the third two-time captain in school history while Poling is only the fourth underclassman to be named a captain.

McCarty joins his brother, Corey, who was captain in 2012 while Walsh follows in the footsteps of his father, Pat, who was a captain in 1988. Pat Walsh is currently a Varsity assistant.

- **Common foe** Jackson and Logan are long time rivals. Since meeting for the first time in 1917, the Chieftains and Ironmen have met 96 times. Amazingly, the series is all square at 46-46-4 all-time. Both schools were members of the SEOAL for all 92 years of its existence, from 1926-2016, with Logan winning a record 26 titles and Jackson winning 25. This is the first ever season opener between the two schools and earliest meeting since they played in week two during the 1920 season. The schools have never met in August.
- **On this date** This will be just the third ever Chieftain football game on August 28. Logan won the prior two games played on the date, and both were significant road victories over rivals. Logan won at Lancaster's Fulton Field 33-14 on their way to a 10-0 regular season in 2009 and opened with a wild 61-49 win at Athens in 2015, the first meeting between those rivals since 2007.
