## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight is the second ever match-up between the Watkins Memorial Warriors and the Logan Chieftains. Twenty-five years ago, Logan made the same trip to Pataskala and lost a thrilling, high scoring game 30-28. This game was scheduled following the changes to the OHSAA season due to the COVID-19 global health crisis.

**Watkins Memorial** is looking to even their overall record at 3-3 before their playoff opener with Northland (Columbus) next Friday. The Warriors defeated rivals Licking Heights (40-13) in week two and downed Utica (49-13) last Friday. The opened the season with a loss to Licking Valley (3-35) and also suffered defeats against Zanesville (13-46) and Granville (9-28).

**Logan** is still searching for their first win having fallen to Jackson (14-48), Amanda-Clearcreek (12-17), Warren (14-28), Bloom-Carroll (0-14), and Logan Elm (21-48). The Chieftains depth was tested last Friday against the Braves as multiple sophomore stepped into significant playing time for the first time this season.

- **Who to watch: Logan ....** Logan will rely on the dual threat of quarterback *Ian Frasure* and the backfield duo of *Caden McCarty* and *Traten Poling*. Poling, who missed the Bloom-Carroll game, returned last week to catch a pair of passes for 62 yards and a touchdown while rushing for 11 yards on a single attempt. Frasure completed 9 of 19 passes for 162 yards and a score while suffering two interceptions. McCarty led the Chiefs with 43 yards and a score on 8 carries.

*McCarty* led the Chiefs with 15 tackles, including 11 solo and one for loss against Logan Elm last week. Linebacker *Cody Carrell* added 9 and a sack while sophomore defensive back *Brayden Sturgell* added 8 including two for loss.

- **Who to watch: Watkins Memorial ....** Running back *Gage Lowery* and quarterback *Liston Shroyer* are key cogs while athlete *Jaleel Sales* requires attention when he is on the field. A beefy offensive line is led by *Anthony Knoblauch*.

Defensively the Warriors are quick and aggressive and make up for their lack of size with physicality. Linebackers *Luke Mumford* and *Noah Bigham* lead the way.

- **On this date ....** This will be the nineteenth Chieftain football game ever played on October 2, with Logan holding an 11-4-3 record. Games on October 2 go back to 1914 and Athens and Nelsonville have both been opponents four times on Oct. 2. Some highlights include Logan's 78-0 victory over the Nelsonville Greyhounds in 1915, Logan's second highest margin of victory and wins during undefeated seasons in 1964 and 2009.
