Game Notes:

Tonight's Match-up Tonight renews an old SEOAL rivalry when the Warren Warriors visit Logan Chieftain Stadium for an early season Senior Night celebration. Warren and Logan met every season from 1986-2017, with all but the last game played under the SEOAL banner. The last ever SEOAL football game was the season finale at Warren in 2016.

Logan leads the all-time series 27-5, but despite that lopsided number the game was tightly contested between 1986 and 1998 and the three overtime games between the two are the most in Logan history.

Warren is in a renaissance under second year head coach Matt Kimes. Kimes, who worked under current LHS grid boss Mike Eddy at Parkersburg South, coached the Warriors to a 6-4 record last fall. Warren topped Marietta 28-6 in a weather shortened season opener and nearly upset Fort Frye last week before falling 27-20. Fort Frye has won 29 straight regular season games.

Logan won four of their final six games to finish 4-6 overall last fall with three of Logan's six losses coming by a single touchdown or less. The Chieftains opened with a 48-14 defeat against perennial playoff qualifier Jackson and lost a tough matchup at Amanda-Clearcreek 17-12 last week.

- Who to watch: Logan On offense, junior *Traten Poling* has been versatile playing in the slot and in the backfield running 5 times for 22 yards and a pair of scores while catching 9 passes for 116 yards. Quarterback *Ian Frasure* completed 13 of 25 passes for 172 yards while running for 49 on 12 carries against the Aces. Senior back *Caden McCarty* caught a pair of passes for 25 yards, including a late game 4-yard score.

Defensively *Poling* recorded 12 tackles last week including one for loss from his outside linebacker post while end *Henry Pierce* pulled down 11 opponents including a sack while also blocking a field goal attempt. Sophomore defensive back *Brayden Sturgell* made 8 stops and broke up a pass.

- Who to watch: Warren The Warrior offense is built around the aerial duo of seniors quarterback *Kurt Taylor* and receiver *Evan Gandee*. The pair have rewritten the WHS record books and had a break out game last Friday. Taylor completed 15 of 24 passes for 240 yards and three touchdowns with Gandee catching 8 for 159 yards and two scores.

Defensively, the blue and white are much improved. Jake Welch is a physical presence at noseguard while outside linebackers Josh Welch and Dylan Keife are athletic and versatile.

- Familiar faces Logan head coach Mike Eddy and Warren head coach Matt Kimes are both in their second year at their new schools. Kimes served as Eddy's offensive coordinator at Parkersburg South High School before both left PSHS for jobs at the Ohio schools.
- Family tradition On paper it would appear that Logan has completely dominated the series between the two schools. Although Logan holds a 27-5 advantage in the series, for the first 15 years the series featured highly competitive games. Logan has played 11 overtime games in its history, but Warren is the only school to have more than one. Logan defeated the Warriors in overtime in 1991 and 1998 while Warren won an overtime game in 2011.

Three of Warren's five wins in the series came in a three year stretch from 1995-1997 when brothers Shawn and Jason Taylor played under center for the Warriors. The '95 team was Warren's only SEOAL football champion

Kurt Taylor, tonight's starting quarterback for the Warriors, is Shawn's son. The Taylor's hope to continue the family tradition with a win over the Chieftains tonight.

- Captains Logan named six captains this fall; Ian Frasure, Caden McCarty, Jonny McClelland, Henry Pierce, Traten Poling, and Quinn Walsh. McClelland is just the third two-time captain in school history while Poling is only the fourth underclassman to be named a captain.

McCarty joins his brother, Corey, who was captain in 2012 while Walsh follows in the footsteps of his father, Pat, who was a captain in 1988. Pat Walsh is currently a Varsity assistant.

- On this date This will be the tenth Chieftain football game ever played on September 11, with Logan holding a 6-3 record. The Chieftains opened their second 10-0 season with a 32-0 win over Bexley in 1964 and poured 64 points on rival Nelsonville-York in a 64-0 win in 1970. Logan's 2009 undefeated team trounced Hamilton Township 49-7 and most recently the 2015 Chieftains scored a late touchdown to down Meigs 27-22 on their way to an 8-2 record.
