Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the 21st meeting between Meigs and Logan – and the seventh since the series renewed in 2014 after a 30-year hiatus. The two schools met as SEOAL rivals from 1967-1982. Meigs formed in 1967 following the consolidation of former SEOAL schools Middleport and Pomeroy, as well as Rutland High School. Logan leads the all-time series 12-7-1 and are 5-1 since the series renewed in 2014.

Meigs enters 2-4 overall but have lost their last two games against Nelsonville-York (6-13) and Athens (35-49). The Marauders opened with a loss to rival Gallipolis (19-22) before an eye-opening 81-36 victory over Belpre. The maroon and gold also fell to River View (14-47).

Logan was blanked by the visiting St. Charles Cardinals last week, 27-0. The red and white did all their scoring in the first half. The loss was disappointing for LHS after back-to-back improved outings in a loss to Chillicothe (21-23) and a win over Athens (24-14). Logan lost their first three games to Jackson (7-42), Teays Valley (6-49), Sheridan (0-33).

- **Homecoming** It's Homecoming at Logan High School, a tradition that dates back to 1933 when the first organized Homecoming activities occurred. Tonight, a king and queen will be announced after selection by the student body. King candidates are: Tegan Myers, Owen Angle, Traten Poling, Carson Hodson, and Ethan St. Clair. Queen candidates are: Alivia Magdich, Blair Kline, Brynn Parks, Kylie Culbertson, and Laikyn Little.
- **Who to watch: Logan** Logan had four freshmen carry the ball last week against St. Charles led by running backs *Kaden Morgan* and *Jeremy Fraley*. *Fraley* had a late touchdown run called back on a penalty. Logan was held to 101 yards on 34 carries and passed for only 13 against the Cardinals.

Defensively the Chieftains were led in tackles by outside linebacker *Ryan Harden* who made 9 stops. Safety *Alex Thompson* and linebacker *Justin Mustard* each made 8 tackles. *Mustard* leads the team in tackles for the season with 43 followed by defensive back *Brayden Sturgell* with 41.

- **Who to watch: Meigs....** The Marauder offense is led by talented four-year starting quarterback *Coulter Cleland*. The senior has completed 74-129 passes for 889 yards and 12 touchdowns with only two interceptions. But running back *Conlee Burnem*, who missed last week's loss to Athens, has been outstanding as well gaining 516 yards and scoring six touchdowns on just 51 attempts. *Griffin Cleland*, *Coulter's* brother, leads the team with 23 catches for 243 yards.

Defensively Meigs is led by linebacker *Andrew Dodson*. *Morgan Roberts* has been solid from his defensive end post with *Jake McElroy* playing well in the secondary.

- **Logan against former Meigs County schools** Prior to consolidation and the formation of Meigs High School, the Middleport Yellow Jackets and Pomeroy Purple Panthers were longtime members of the old Southeastern Ohio Athletic League.

Middleport was a SE Ohio powerhouse during the 1930s and won nine SEOAL titles while amassing a 108-134-10 league record from 1929-1966. Logan held a 24-11-1 record against the Yellow Jackets.

Pomeroy won a single league title in 1955 while amassing a record of 107-133-21 as a member of the SEOAL. Logan was 21-10-4 against the Panthers.

- **Captains** Logan's 2021 captains are seniors Keiton Arledge, Carson Hodson, Justin Mustard, and Traten Poling. Poling is the fourth two-time captain in school history joining Anthony Schrader (1920, 21), Dakota Dement (2016, 17), and Jonny McClelland (2019, 20).

Hodson joins his brother Carson (2017) as a full-time captain.

- **On this date** Tonight will be the fifteenth game played by Logan HS on October 8 with the Chiefs holding a 12-2 record on the date. The first game was a 0-20 loss against Clinton Hi from Columbus in 19215 and they most recently played on October 8 in 2010, a 15-10 win over Warren.

Other memorable games played on Oct. 8 include a 22-19 victory over Ironton in 1971 – the Tigers last SEOAL loss until 1976 and Logan came from behind to defeat Jackson 25-14 in 1976 to kick-start a league championship run.
