Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the first ever meeting between Fort Frye and Logan. The Cadets' success over the last 14 seasons has made filling a schedule challenging, and the Washington Countians have not shied away from outstanding competition.

Fort Frye enters 6-1 overall following an off-week due to a COVID-19 related cancellation last week. The Cadets started the season 6-0 before falling to small-school power Lima Central Catholic on a neutral field last week, 30-23. The Cadets have defeated small school powers St. Henry (16-12) and Trimble (45-13) and beat much larger Zanesville (26-13) earlier this season. The Cadets have more playoff points than any other team in Division VI.

Logan won a thrilling 17-10 victory over Meigs last week. The Chieftains trailed 10-0 at halftime before blanking the Marauders in the second half and scored the winning touchdown with less than 30 seconds to play in the game. Logan has won two of their last three topping Athens 24-14 and dropping a 27-0 loss to St. Charles.

- **Close call** Logan's Brayden Sturgell crossed the goal line with :29.2 remaining in last week's thrilling win over Meigs. It was the latest game-winning touchdown since 2013 when the Chieftains scored with 0:22 to play against Jackson to clinch their last SEOAL title. Over the last twenty years the Chiefs have also kicked three game-winning field goals in the final 30 seconds.
- **Call it a comeback** Logan's rally from a 10-0 halftime deficit was also historic. It was the first time LHS trailed by 10+ points at halftime and rallied for a victory since rallying from a 16-6 halftime deficit against Jackson in 1963 in a 20-16 win. It was just the third such comeback in school history – Logan also rallied to a 14-13 win over Pomeroy in 1954 after trailing at halftime 13-0.

Logan's largest comeback in school history came against Minford in 2017 when the Falcons led 35-7 in the third quarter before the Purple & White rallied to a 48-42 double-overtime win.

- **Halftime adjustments** Logan has not allowed a second half point in their last three games – including wins over Athens and Meigs. The Chiefs haven't allowed a second half point in their last six quarters of second half football.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Quarterback *Brayden Sturgell* led the Logan offense last week gaining 98 yards and scoring twice on 22 carries while wingback *Varik Fick* added 56 yards on 13 carries. Senior captain *Carson Hodson* not only provided excellent blocking, but he booted a 37-yard field goal and a pair of PATs.

Defensively *Dalton Brooks* paced LHS from his end position making 10 stops including one for loss and a quarterback sack. Senior captain *Justin Mustard* added nine stops, including one for loss, and broke up an enemy pass attempt.

- **Who to watch: Fort Frye....** The Cadet offense is led by a pair of talented wing backs in *Owen Brown* and *Maeson Long*. The duo has rushed for 393 and 671 yards respectively. Long and quarterback *Ian Ellis* have both rushed for seven touchdowns with Ellis also completing an efficient 51 of 70 passes for 664 yards with eight touchdowns against a lone interception.

The Cadet defense is fast, disciplined, and physical operating out of a base 4-4. *Hunter Kesselring* and *Kaleb Bailey* pace the forward wall while *Zaiden Huck* and *Elijah Johnson* are excellent linebackers. *Ellis* has made a team high 49 stops from the safety spot while *Long* has a team leading five interceptions.

- **Captains** Logan's 2021 captains are seniors Keiton Arledge, Carson Hodson, Justin Mustard, and Traten Poling. Poling is the fourth two-time captain in school history joining Anthony Schrader (1920, 21), Dakota Dement (2016, 17), and Jonny McClelland (2019, 20).

Hodson joins his brother Carson (2017) as a full-time captain.

- **On this date** Tonight will be the twelfth game played by Logan HS on October 15 with the Chiefs holding a 9-3 record on the date. The first game ever played by Logan on October 15th was the dedication of the old Hilltop stadium, later known as Bill Sauer Field, in 1937. Logan lost that game to Gallipolis 20-19.
