Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is Senior Night at Logan Chieftain Stadium and the 25th meeting between Logan and Zanesville. The two schools first met way back in 1923, but the second game wasn't played until 1991 and the schools have met almost every year since that second matchup. The Blue Devils lead the all-time series 14-10. Playoff seeding is on the line for ZHS while Logan hopes to end a difficult campaign on a positive note.

Zanesville, member of the Licking County League, enter 5-3 overall and 4-1 against LCL competition. But the record is deceiving the three losses came against teams with a combined 24-1 record. Zanesville knocked off rival Newark (41-0) in the season opener and also recorded wins over Heath (48-7), Licking Valley (20-10), Licking Heights (34-14), and last week against Watkins Memorial (40-27). Their losses came to 9-0 Big Walnut (19-42), 7-1 Fort Frye (13-26), and 8-0 Granville (13-35).

Logan was outclassed by Fort Frye in Beverly last Friday, committing three turnovers and failing to establish anything on the offensive side of the football in a 49-14 loss. The Chieftains were routed in their three opening games against Jackson (7-42), Teays Valley (6-49), and Sheridan (0-33) – but those three teams are a combined 22-5. Logan has been more competitive in the back half of the schedule falling to Chillicothe (21-23) and St. Charles (0-27) and defeating rival Athens (24-14) and Meigs (17-10).

- **Going streaking** The Logan-Zanesville series has been one of winning streaks by each school. ZHS won the first ever meeting in 1923, but then proceeded to win the first eight win the series renewed in 1991. Logan finally knocked off the Blue Devils in 1999, and won ten straight meeting between then and 2009 (no game was played in 2003). But since that last Logan victory, the Blue Devils have won the last five matchups.
- **Who to watch: Logan** Freshman running back *Kaden Morgan* was a lone bright spot for the Purple & White last week – catching a pair of fourth quarter passes for 36 yards and a touchdown from sophomore back-up quarterback *Wyatt Woodgeard*.

Defensively senior linebacker *Justin Mustard* recorded 9 stops against the Cadets, including two for loss, and leads LHS on the season with 61 total tackles. End *Dalton Brooks* added five stops including two for loss. Defensive back *Brayden Sturgell* is second on the team with 44 total tackles.

- **Who to watch: Zanesville** It will be a double-dose of the wing-t offense as Zanesville will look to use a big athletic offensive led by senior tackle *Julian Jackson* to control the clock and the line of scrimmage. Senior *Jordan Martin* averages nearly nine-yards per carry and has scored 10 touchdowns as a wingback. *Kanye Evans* is a goal line threat as a pass catching tight end (five receptions, 71 yards, three touchdowns) and as a short yardage fullback (23 carries, 153 yards, seven touchdowns).

Defensively the Blue Devil linebacking unit is strong led by leading tackler *Conner Wade*. Up front *Evans* shares the team lead in sacks with *Wade*. In the secondary *Isaac Mayle* and *Trey Wyatt* lead the team in interceptions.

- **Traditional Senior Walk** Tonight twelve seniors will play their final home football game and following the game the team will lock arms and make the annual senior walk, a tradition started in 2001.

Kaiden Patton, Trace Sigafocce, Kenton Nester, Chase Sharp, Traten Poling, Justin Mustard, Carson Hodson, Isaiah Campbell, Christian Blount, Mason Linton, Keiton Arledge, and Domanic Burnside will all make their final appearance as Chieftains.

Hodson joins his brother Carson (2017) as a full-time captain.

- **On this date** Tonight will be the fifteenth game played by Logan HS on October 22 with the Chiefs holding a 10-4 record on the date. The first game ever played by Logan on October 22nd was an 18-0 loss at Columbus East in 1921. In 2004 Logan took control of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League title race in a shocking 43-13 win at Gallipolis. The two teams would share the title at the end of the season.
