Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight is the third all-time meeting between the Logan Chieftains and the Sheridan Generals. The two teams were long time scrimmage partners before playing their first regular season game in 2017. The Generals have won all three match-ups and last season's game was cancelled due to changes to the OHSAA playoff caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Sheridan has started 2-0 with wins over perennial playoff qualifiers Licking Valley (35-30) and Jonathan Alder (18-14). They are following up an excellent 2020 season when they reached the regional semifinal, won the Muskingum Valley League championship, and finished 8-1.

Logan has been thoroughly outplayed in season opening losses to Jackson (42-7) and Teays Valley (49-6). Injuries have played a factor, but a struggling offense is failing to control the clock like Coach Eddy expected.

- **Captains** Logan's 2021 captains are seniors Keiton Arledge, Carson Hodson, Justin Mustard, and Traten Poling. Poling is the fourth two-time captain in school history joining Anthony Schrader (1920, 21), Dakota Dement (2016, 17), and Jonny McClelland (2019, 20).

Hodson joins his brother Carson (2017) as a full-time captain.

- **On this date** Tonight, will be the sixth LHS game ever played on September 3 with Logan holding a 2-2-1 record on the date. The Chiefs most recently played on this date in 2010, a 24-3 loss at Pickerington North.
