Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the first meeting between the Buckeye Valley Barons and the Logan Chieftains. Logan, who will enter the Ohio Capital Conference in time for the 2024-25 school year, scheduled the two year series with the Delaware Countians to round out one of their late season bye weeks. Due to changes in Buckeye Valley's league commitments, a return trip to Logan won't happen next year.

Buckeye Valley has won their last four games – all against Mid-State League Ohio division competition – after starting 0-3. The Barons opened with losses to strong teams in Delaware-Hayes (14-28), Jonathan Alder (7-21), and Ashland (16-34). They have topped Bishop Ready (36-35 OT), Bexley (15-7), Columbus Academy (22-0), and Grandview Heights (23-6) to start league play.

Logan took a 21-7 lead against St. Charles last week and with stood a fourth quarter comeback attempt to top the Cardinals 21-20. Logan stopped a late 2-point conversion attempt to seal the victory. Logan has won three of their last four – defeating St. Charles, Athens (35-13), and Warren (17-14) and losing to Chillicothe (0-24) in that stretch. Logan dropped their first three games to Jackson (8-35), Teays Valley (7-17), and Sheridan (7-28). Logan's four losses come against teams that are a combined 21-7.

- **Chieftains 110** This fall, Logan will celebrate the 110th anniversary of their first football season in 1912. The school will hold a Celebration of Champions on September 16, welcoming back anniversary championship teams from 1952, 1977, 1987, 1992, and 2007.

Logan has won 580 games, 26 SEOAL championships, and made nine playoff appearances. LoganFootball.com will be writing a long form story on the 1952 champions for their 70th anniversary, has prepared a pregame video for the video board featuring footage from as early as 1950, and will be compiling a list of the 110 greatest players in school history.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Senior halfback *Varik Fick* is the Chieftains leading rusher with 725 yards and six touchdowns on 111 carries, but sophomore wingback *Kaden Morgan* has combined for 210 yards and two touchdowns on 27 carries in the last two games. Senior *Brayden Sturgell* will be used as a situational quarterback in wildcat sets and has run for 177 yards on 32 carries and a touchdown so far this season.

Defensively, junior linebacker *Jack Brown* leads LHS with 60 stops including five for loss and a sack while senior end *Ryan Harden* adds 50 tackles and four for loss with a sack. Sophomore *Kallen Wilson* leads the team with three sacks.

- **Who to watch: Buckeye Valley** Freshman quarterback *Nathan Huss* is efficient with both his arm and legs and has a group of physical and experienced receivers in *Brady Ridder, Mitchell Melfe, and Garrett Carey*. *Connor Hardman* plays a key role as an H-back and left tackle *Ridge Webb* moves people in the run game and has good footwork in pass protection.

Defensively, linebackers *Sam Jones, Luke Hrynkow, Garrett Slater, and Landon Froehlich* are versatile and physical. Hybrid linebacker-defensive back *Ripley Sznati* can cause matchup problems with *Melfe, Ridder, and Ethan Browning* playing very well in the back end.

- **White lids...** The Chieftains are wearing white helmets this season for the first time since 1985. Logan only wore white in the post leather helmet era until switching to purple in 1986 but have brought back the white lids thanks to a campaign led by former Chieftains from the 1970s. The spear on the side of the helmet has been worn as far back as 1970 and consistently since that same 1986 season.
- **Captains** Logan's 2022 captains are seniors Dalton Brooks, Varik Fick, Brayden Sturgell, and Izaac Swope. Sturgell follows his uncle Josh, a current LHMS coach, who was an LHS football captain in 2003.
- **On this date** Tonight, will be the 16th game ever played by LHS on October 7 with the Chieftains holding a 6-9 record on this date. They first played on this date in 1921, a 34-0 win over Jackson and most recently lost to Jackson 14-46 in 2016. In one of the most memorable games in school history, Logan defeated Ironton 20-14 away from home, a key victory on the way to a perfect 10-0 season in 1977.
